Planning

This whimsical quilt will get you in the mood for Halloween. Sandy machine quilted the appliqué with a blanket stitch through all layers to make this quick project. The raw-edge ghosts are enhanced by straight

stitch just inside the edges in black thread. Sandy used variegated thread on the witch hat and bat. The remaining blanket stitching was done with thread to match appliqués.

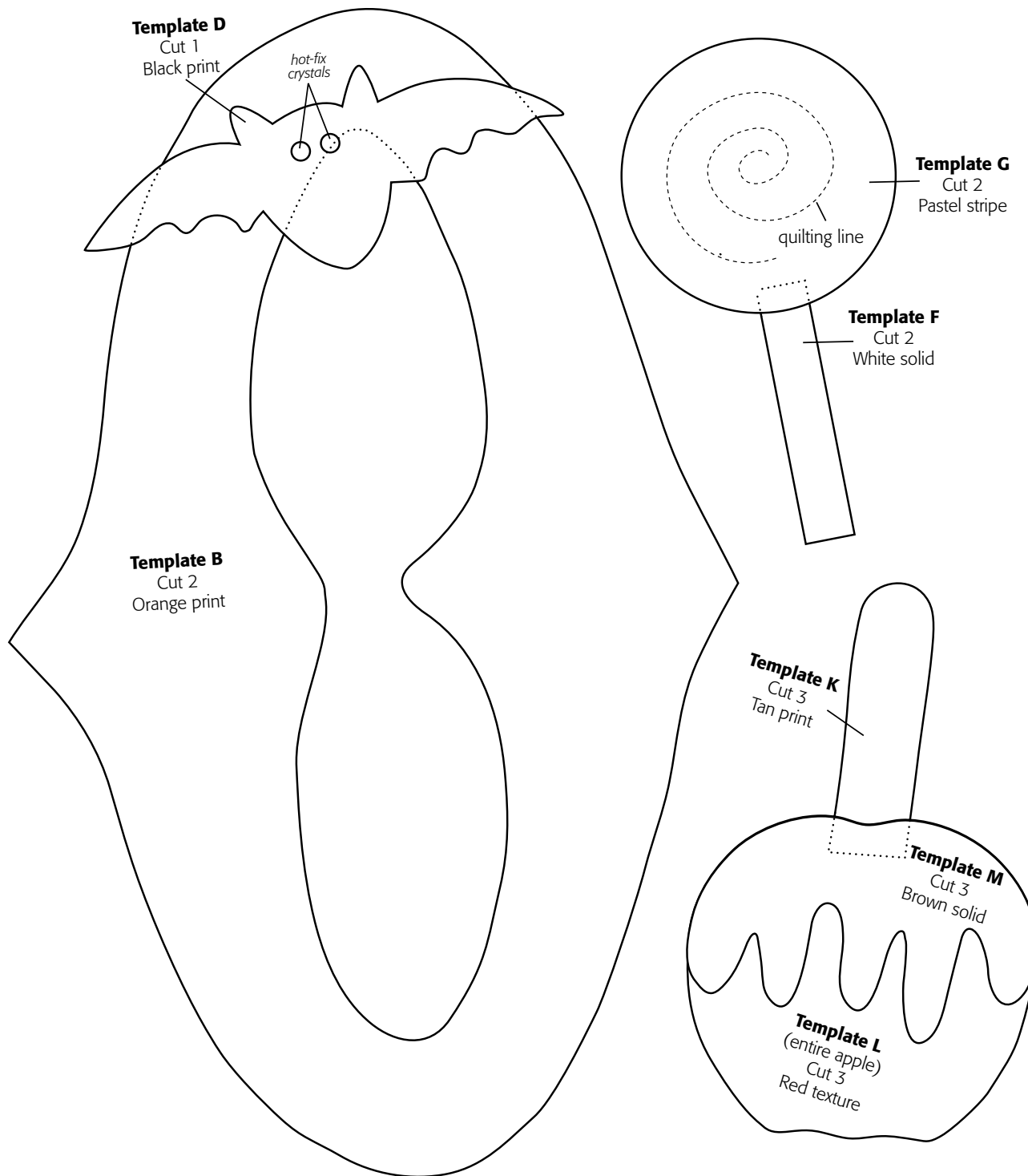
Skill Level **Beginner**

Finished Wall Hanging Size
25½" x 27½"

Note: Appliqué templates (at end of pattern) are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

Fabric Requirements

Orange print (letters, outer border)	½ yd.
Black print (hat, bat)	7" x 8" piece
White solid (lollipop sticks, ghosts)	6" x 7" piece
Pastel stripe (lollipops, candy)	6" x 7" piece
Red texture (candy, apples)	8" x 10" piece
Tan print (apple sticks)	5" x 6" piece
Brown solid (apple caramel)	5" x 8" piece
Purple spiderweb print (background, pinwheels)	⅝ yd.
Lime mottle (pinwheels, inner border)	¾ yd.
Black texture (binding)	½ yd.
Paper-backed fusible web	1 yd.
Backing	1 yd.
Batting size	32" x 34"
Embroidery floss, black (optional)	
Hot-fix crystal applicator (optional)	
Dark and light fabric markers
