Green floral and brown dot
(star points) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ piece each
Tan/blue small floral (block backgrounds) 1 fat quarter*
Gold/red medium floral (block background, binding)
Tan/blue large floral (block centers) 1 fat eighth**
Blue/white print (inner border)
Red check (outer border)
Backing
Batting size
$1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$.
$3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$.
$11 / 2 \mathrm{yds}$. or $24^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}$ piece $24^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}$
*A fat quarter is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric.
**A fat eighth is a 9 " $\times 20-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric.

## Cut

## (in order listed)

4 squares $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ Green floral and brown dotcut from each:

2 squares $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
Tan/blue small floral
2 squares $71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \boxtimes$
8 squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Gold/red medium floral
4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ width of fabric (WOF) for binding
1 square $71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 714^{\prime \prime}$
4 squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \boxtimes$
Tan/blue large floral
3 squares $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Blue/white print
*2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
*2 strips $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14$ "
Red check
*2 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 3 WOF strips
*2 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$
*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Sew

1 Draw 2 diagonal lines on wrong side of red dot $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram I-A, place marked square on blue vine print $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of one line. Cutting on unsewn line first, then on remaining drawn line, cut sewn square into quarters. Open and press to make 4 pieced triangles. Make 16 total.


Diagram I-A
In same manner, use green floral and brown dot squares to make 8 total pieced triangles (Diagram I-B).


2 Sew 2 red/blue pieced triangles (1 of each orientation) to tan/blue small floral $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ quarter-square triangle to make pieced rectangle (Diagram II-A). Make 8.


In same manner, use green/brown pieced triangles and gold/red medium floral triangles to make 4 pieced rectangles of 2nd arrangement (Diagram II-B).


3 Sew 3 rows using 4 tan/blue small floral $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 4 red/blue pieced rectangles, and tan/blue large floral $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square (Diagram III-A). Sew rows together to make Star Block. Make 2.

In same manner, make 1 block of 2nd arrangement (Diagram III-B).

4 Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. Stitch blocks together, alternating colors.


5 Sew blue/white print $14^{\prime \prime}$ strips to short sides; trim even with long sides. Sew blue/white WOF strips to long sides; trim even with short sides. Stitch red check $18^{\prime \prime}$ strips to short sides; trim even. Stitch red check 46 " strips to long sides; trim even.
6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with gold/red medium floral.
