Web Bonus: Pumpkin Parade Lap-Size Quilt (Just Pumpkins!)

Adapted from a Quilt Designed by CHRISTY BOWMAN

Finished Quilt Size 62¹/2" x 62¹/2"

SKILL LEVEL CONFIDENT BEGINNER

Fabric Requirements Cream texture (background) Orange paisley, orange print, and orange mottle (pumpkins) Olive mottle (pumpkin stems, binding) Rust stripe (sashing, border) Black mottle (sashing posts) Backing Batting size *See Planning and Cutting.

2 yds.

5% yd. **each** 3⁄4 yd. 17⁄8 yd.* 7″ x 7″ piece 41⁄8 yds. 72″ x 72″





You'll find the pattern for this larger $(75^{1/2}" \times 75^{1/2}")$ quilt, with a fun appliquéd border, in the September/October 2014 issue of *McCall's Quilting*.

Planning and Cutting

These fun strip-pieced pumpkins set the stage for autumn celebrations. This quilt features a rust stripe for the sashing and border; our yardage requirements and cutting have you cut this fabric so the stripes run vertically throughout the quilt. If you choose a non-directional print for this fabric, you can piece the 4 border strips from 8 width-of-fabric strips and cut all sashing strips on the crosswise grain, which requires only 1 yard. **Cutting Instructions** (cut in order listed) Cream texture 18 strips 41/4" x 121/2" 18 squares 27/8" x 27/8" 18 strips 21/2" x 181/2" 18 strips 21/2" x 81/2" Orange paisley and orange print-cut from each: 3 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ x width of fabric (WOF) 9 squares 27/8" x 27/8" 9 strips 21/2" x 7" Orange mottle 6 strips 21/2" x WOF Olive mottle 7 strips 21/2" x WOF (binding) 9 squares 21/2" x 21/2" Rust stripe *2 strips 21/2" x length of fabric (LOF) *2 strips 21/2" x 66", pieced from 4 strips 21/2" x 35" cut on crosswise grain 6 strips 21/2" x 181/2", cut on lengthwise grain 6 strips 21/2" x 181/2", cut on crosswise grain Black mottle 4 squares 21/2" x 21/2" *Border strips include extra length for trimming.


Piecing the Blocks

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of cream texture 27%" square. Referring to **Diagram I**, place marked square on orange paisley 27%" square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 18. In same manner, make 18 pieced squares with cream texture and orange print.



2 Join 2 paisley/cream pieced squares to paisley 7" strip as shown in **Diagram II**, to make pieced strip. Make 9. Make 9 pieced strips from orange print/cream pieced squares and orange print 7" strips.




Referring to Diagram III, sew together 2 orange mottle, 1 orange print, and 1 orange paisley WOF strips to make strip set. Make 3. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 9 segments 11" wide.



Sew orange paisley pieced strip and orange print pieced strip to segment (Diagram IV). Stitch cream 4¹/₄" x 12¹/₂" strips to sides to make pumpkin unit. Make 9.

*x*²/₁²/₁ *x*⁺/₁/₁/₁ *Make* 9 Diagram IV **6** Referring to **Diagram V**, sew together 2 cream 8½[°] strips and olive mottle 2½[°] square; sew to top of pumpkin unit. Add 2 cream 18½[°] strips to complete Pumpkin Block. Make 9.






Assembling the Quilt Top

Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. Watch stripe orientation throughout.
Stitch 3 rows of 3 blocks and 2 rust stripe 181/2" strips each. Sew 2 rows of 3 rust strips and 2 brown texture 21/2" squares each. Join rows, alternating.

Sew rust LOF strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining rust strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

Quilting and Finishing

8 Layer, baste, and quilt as desired. Bind with olive mottle.
