## Web Bonus: Pumpkin Parade Lap-Size Quilt (Just Pumpkins!)

| Rust stripe (sashing, border) | $17 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. |
| Black mottle (sashing posts) | $7 " \times 77^{\prime \prime}$ piece |
| Backing | $41 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$. |
| Batting size | $72^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$ |

Finished Quilt Size
$62 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$



You'll find the pattern for this larger $\left(751 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 751 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ quilt, with a fun appliquéd border, in the September/October 2014 issue of McCall's Quilting.

## Planning and Cutting

These fun strip-pieced pumpkins set the stage for autumn celebrations. This quilt features a rust stripe for the sashing and border; our yardage requirements and cutting have you cut this fabric so the stripes run vertically throughout the quilt. If you choose a non-directional print for this fabric, you can piece the 4 border strips from 8 width-of-fabric strips and cut all sashing strips on the crosswise grain, which requires only 1 yard.

## Cutting Instructions (cut in order listed) <br> Cream texture

18 strips $414^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
18 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
18 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
18 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Orange paisley and orange print-cut
from each:
3 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (WOF)
9 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
9 strips $212^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$
Orange mottle
6 strips $212^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
Olive mottle
7 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF (binding)
9 squares $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1122^{\prime \prime}}{}$
Rust stripe
*2 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ length of fabric (LOF)
*2 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35^{\prime \prime}$ cut on crosswise grain
6 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut on lengthwise grain
6 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$, cut on crosswise grain
Black mottle
4 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Piecing the Blocks

(1) Draw diagonal line on wrong side of cream texture $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram I, place marked square on orange paisley $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 18. In same manner, make 18 pieced squares with cream texture and orange print.


## Diagram I

2. Join 2 paisley/cream pieced squares to paisley 7" strip as shown in Diagram II, to make pieced strip. Make 9. Make 9 pieced strips from orange print/cream pieced squares and orange print 7 " strips.


## Diagram II

Referring to Diagram III, sew together 2 orange mottle, 1 orange print, and 1 orange paisley WOF strips to make strip set. Make 3. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 9 segments $11^{\prime \prime}$ wide.

Sew orange paisley pieced strip and orange print pieced strip to segment (Diagram IV). Stitch cream $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides to make pumpkin unit. Make 9.


Diagram IVReferring to Diagram V, sew together 2 cream $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and olive mottle $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square; sew to top of pumpkin unit. Add 2 cream 181/2" strips to complete Pumpkin Block. Make 9.

Assembling the Quilt Top
Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. Watch stripe orientation throughout. 6 Stitch 3 rows of 3 blocks and 2 rust stripe $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips each. Sew 2 rows of 3 rust strips and 2 brown texture $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares each. Join rows, alternating.

Sew rust LOF strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining rust strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

Quilting and Finishing
8 Layer, baste, and quilt as desired. Bind with olive mottle.
