Note: Appliqué templates are at end of pattern. Appliqué templates are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

## Plan

Nanette's welcoming pillow was made with graphic prints from the Spooktacular Eve collection by Maude Asbury for Blend Fabrics, appliqued onto a textured waffle weave background. She fussy cut the A and $D$ patches to make best use of the prints. She also used un-fused raw-edge appliqué, and the appliqué edges are covered by the Chenille-lt™ Blooming Bias trim for a fun, textured effect. To add similar chenille accents to your appliqué pillow, place the bias strip along the outer edge of each appliqué patch. Using a shortened machine stitch, sew down the center of the bias strip to secure it to the surface. Black rickrack trim on the outer seam of the pillow completes the look.

*A fat eighth is a 9 " $\times 20-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric.

1 fat eighth* each
$35 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$.
$21 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$.
$11 / 2 \mathrm{yds}$.
$1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$.

1 rectangle $14^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ Backing fabric

2 rectangles $12 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$

## Sew

1 Note: The cream waffle weave rectangle is cut oversized to allow for shrinkage during appliqué. Referring to Diagram I, arrange appliqué patches in alphabetical order on cream waffle weave $14^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, keeping in mind that rectangle will be trimmed to $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ (finished size is $12^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ ). Appliqué in place. Place Chenille-lt ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Blooming Bias trim along edges of appliqué patches. Stitch down the center of strip, through appliqué and background, to secure. If desired, use a stiletto to keep strip in place while sewing. Trim panel to $12 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}} \times 24 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.



## Diagram I

2 Referring to Diagram II, baste black rickrack to waffle weave panel, aligning points with raw edges, pivoting rickrack at corners and overlapping ends.


Diagram II

3 Referring to Diagram III, turn under 1" twice on 1 short edge of backing fabric $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle; press. Stitch close to fold through all layers. Make 2.


Diagram III
Layer pillow front and both backing rectangles, right sides together and raw edges aligned (Diagram IV). Hemmed sides of backing rectangles will overlap at center. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from raw edges. Trim corners and turn right side out through opening at overlapped edges. Press edges.


4 Insert pillow form inside pillow cover through flaps.
