## SEW EASY Trimming Oversized Triangle-Squares

Try this method to make perfect triangle-squares every time.


1. Using squares that are 1 " $-1 \frac{1}{8}$ " larger than desired finished size of triangle-square, align $45^{\circ}$ line of ruler along diagonal seam of triangle-square, allowing top and right edges to extend slightly past the edges of ruler.

2. Trim along top and right edge of ruler.

3. Turn triangle-square. Align ruler's $45^{\circ}$ line with seam, and unit's cut edges with desired measurements. Trim top and right sides to square up unit.
