## **SEW EASY**<sup>™</sup> Managing Bulky Seams

These clever strategies can greatly reduce the bulk at seam intersections.



**1.** To reduce bulk at center of a pinwheel, sew four triangle-square units together as shown.



**2.** Clip threads in center seam allowance at intersection, to edge of last sewn seam, as shown.



**3.** Press triangle units so that horizontal seams "pinwheel" in different directions.



**1.** To reduce bulk at a Y-seam intersection, sew unit as instructed, creating vertical seam and then setting in third patch.



**2.** To reduce bulk, first press vertical seam open. Then press seam allowance away from set-in piece.
