Submission Guidelines

Design submissions may be any size, placemats to baby quilts, wall hangings to lap or bed size; multiple submissions are welcome. And as always, if you have an outstanding quilt design for us to consider, even if it doesn't quite fit the issue theme, we welcome that too!

Important Notes:

- Design submissions are due by **March 13, 2023** for consideration. Please send your previously unpublished ideas (including blogs and social media) in PDF or JPG format, along with the completed Submission Form (see following page).
- Digital issues will be live on September 19, 2023 and at newsstands about October 3, 2023. If your quilt features a specific fabric collection, please consider the timing of its availability to accommodate readers who will want to recreate your design!
- Once accepted, we will work with you directly to choose fabrics you love and get you in touch with the fabric manufacturers to supply fabrics.
- Finished quilts would be due in our Golden, Colorado office **no later than May 18, 2023**.
