	Brown scroll print (blocks)	⅝ yd.	6

	Brown/pink leaf print (blocks)	⅝ yd.	6

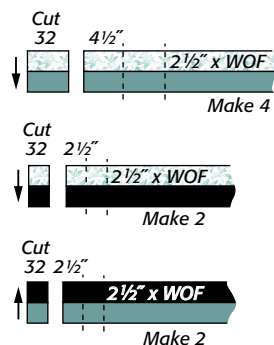

## Plan

Kathy designed these strip-pieced "O" and "X" blocks to represent hugs and kisses. She used toile, prints, and florals from her Emma Grace collection by Red Rooster Fabrics. Both block arrangements are made from the same quarter-block units. Hug Blocks and Kiss Blocks alternate to create diagonal chains of black floral squares across the quilt. The blue, red/pink, and brown blocks are also arranged diagonally.

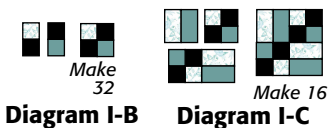
## Sew

- Note:** The following instructions are for blocks made with the 1st fabric combination. Referring to **Diagram I-A**, sew together 1 white/blue toile and 1 blue/pink leaf print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips to make strip set. Make 4. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 32 segments  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. In the same manner, make 4 remaining strip sets, press, and cut segments in fabric combinations, widths, and quantities shown.

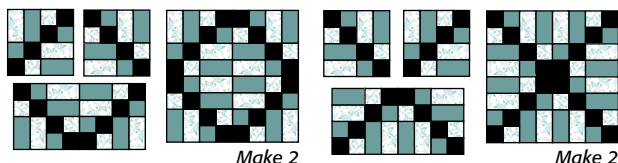
- Sew 2 different  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments together to make 4-patch (**Diagram I-B**). Make 32. Sew together two  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " segments and two 4-patches to make quarter-block (**Diagram I-C**). Make 16.

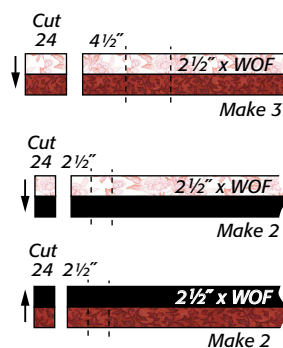
- Referring to **Diagrams I-D** and **I-E**, sew together 4 quarter-blocks each to make 2 Hug Blocks and 2 Kiss Blocks.



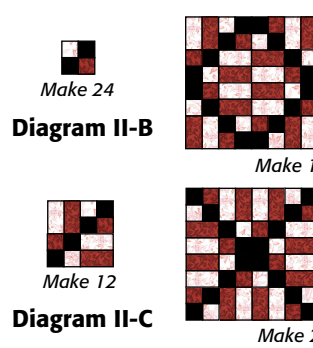

- Repeat Steps 1 through 3 to make remaining strip sets and blocks in fabric combinations, arrangements, and quantities shown in **Diagrams II-A** through **X-D**.

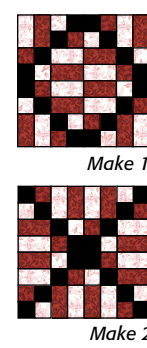

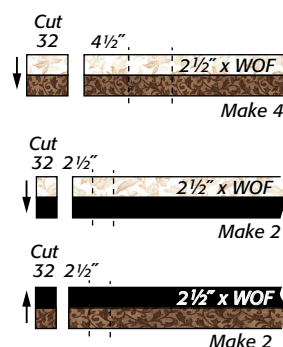

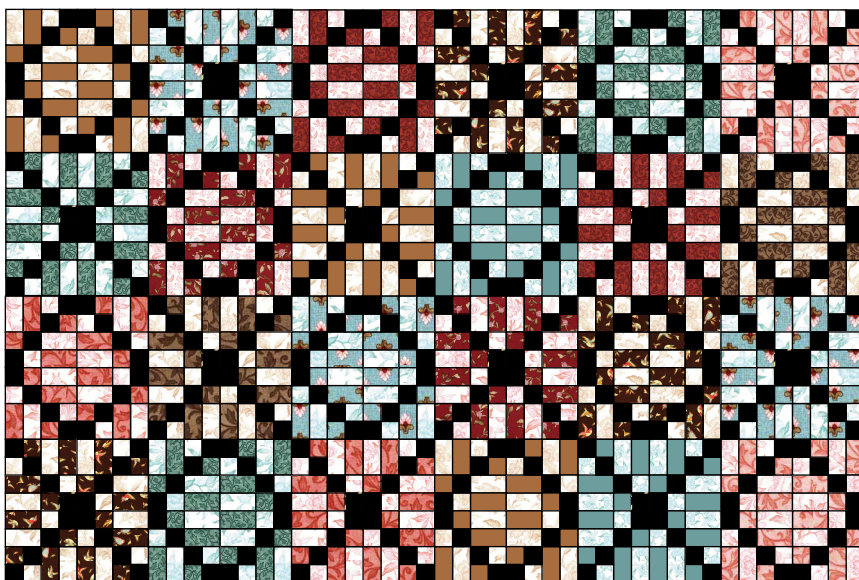
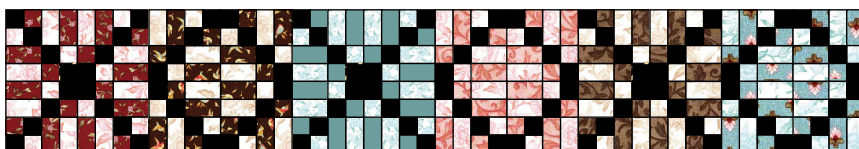


- 5 Referring to the **Assembly Diagram**, stitch 6 rows of 6 blocks each. Sew rows together.
- 6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with black floral.
