Cheddar solid (sashing)
Backing (piece lengthwise)
$11 / 4 \mathrm{yds}$. total

## Planning a Reproduction

Album blocks have long been a favorite of quilters. Use light and dark fabrics from your stash to imbue each block with a memory of quilts you've already made. Notice that the maker alternated her use of lights and darks, sometimes using a darker fabric for the 16 squares (and lighter fabric for the 9 squares) and in other blocks using a lighter fabric for the 16 squares. Plan your desired arrangement before cutting the assorted plaids/ prints/stripes.

## Cutting Instructions

Assorted plaids/prints/stripes-
cut 20 sets of:
16 matching squares $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
9 matching squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Assorted cream prints-
cut 20 matching sets of:
3 squares $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half twice diagonally to make 12 quarter-square triangles
2 squares $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 4 half-square triangles
Navy solid
8 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (WOF) for binding
22 strips 2" x WOF
Cheddar solid
11 strips 2" x WOF
12 squares 5" x 5"


Album blocks were a popular 19th century way to say "I love you." Dress and shirt scraps were wheedled from friends and relatives, who then signed the blocks that their fabrics were used to make. Many of the fabrics in this quilt date from the Civil War, when piecing possibly began. However, some of the blocks were finished with shirtings and enclosed by navy and cheddar yellow sashing more typical of the late 1800s.

## Piecing the Blocks

(1)
From assorted plaids/prints/stripes, select 9 matching $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 16 matching $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, and 12 matching assorted cream $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ quartersquare triangles. Referring to Diagram I, stitch 7 diagonal rows. Sew rows together. Stitch 4 matching assorted cream $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ half-square triangles to corners. Note: Setting triangles are cut slightly oversized to allow trimming. Trim block to $117 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 20 total Album Blocks.


Make 20 total; trim to $117 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square

## Diagram I

2Sew navy solid 2" x WOF strips to sides of cheddar solid 2" x WOF strip (see Diagram II). Make 11. Press in direction of arrows. Cut 31 segments $117 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ wide.

## Assembling the Quilt Top

(3) Referring to Assembly Diagram, position 4 Album Blocks and 3 strip segments. Stitch 5 block rows. Alternating 4 strip segments and 3 cheddar solid 5 " squares, sew 4 sashing rows. Alternating block rows and sashing rows, stitch rows together.

## Quilting and Finishing

Layer, baste, and quilt. The maker hand quilted diagonal lines $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ apart through the Album Blocks, horizontal lines $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ apart in the strip segments, and diagonal quilting lines $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ apart in the cheddar squares. Bind with navy solid.
