Assorted orange prints/ textures/mottles Assorted gold, brown, rust, and green prints/ textures/mottles Green texture (bindings) Backing **Batting**

3/4-1 yd. total*

3/4-1 yd. total* 3/4 yd. 11/2 yds. 36" x 48" piece

Planning

This pattern is for 4 place mats to coordinate with the American Maize table runner featured in the September/October 2014 issue of McCall's Quilting.

Cutting Instructions

Assorted orange prints/textures/mottles-cut a total of:

32 strips 2" x 13"

Assorted gold, brown, rust, and green prints/ textures/mottles-cut a total of:

32 strips 2" x 13"

Green texture


8 strips 21/2" x width of fabric (bindings) Backing **and** batting—**cut from each:**

*4 rectangles 18" x 24"

*Cut backing rectangles on lengthwise grain.

Making the Place Mat Tops

1 Referring to Diagram I, sew together 4 assorted orange and 4 assorted gold/brown/ rust/green 13" strips, alternating, to make strip set. Make 8 total. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 48 segments 2" wide.



2 Sew 12 segments together, alternating direction of pressed seams, to make place mat top (Diagram II). Make 4 total.

Quilting and Finishing

Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with green texture.


