
Number of Blocks and Finished Size 12 Churn Dash Blocks 10" x 10"

Fabric Requirements

Assorted purple and blue 3/4-11/4 yds. solids (blocks) total Black solid (blocks, border, binding) 35/8 yds. Gray solid (blocks, sashing) 11/8 yds. Fuchsia solid (sashing posts) 1/4 yd. Backing (piece lengthwise) 43/4 yds. 72" x 84" Batting size

Planning

By doubling the finished sizes of the blocks and other elements, John's striking wall hanging design becomes a dramatic lap size quilt. John used black and gray patches interchangeably in his block piecing, and placed assorted purple and blue patches randomly, giving the design depth and additional interest. The wide black border is a perfect place to showcase machine or hand quilting.



The pattern for the wall hanging (311/2" x 371/2") size of this design is in the January/February 2012 issue of McCall's Quilting.

Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

Assorted purple and blue solids—cut a total of:

24 squares 47/8" x 47/8"

48 squares 21/2" x 21/2"

Black solid

*2 strips 121/2" x 66", cut on lengthwise grain

*2 strips 121/2" x 54", cut on lengthwise grain

6 strips 21/2" x 52", cut on lengthwise grain (binding)

17 squares 41/8" x 41/8"

48 squares 21/2" x 21/2"

Gray solid

7 squares 47/8" x 47/8"

31 strips 21/2" x 101/2"

12 squares 21/2" x 21/2"

Fuchsia solid

20 squares 21/2" x 21/2"

*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

Piecing the Blocks

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of assorted purple or blue 47/8" square. Place marked square on black or gray 47/8" square, right sides together (Diagram I). Sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 48 total.




Diagram I

2 Sew together 1 black or gray and 1 purple or blue 21/2" square to make pieced rectangle (Diagram II). Make 48 total.

3 Referring to Diagram III, sew 3 rows using 4 pieced squares, 4 pieced rectangles, and 1 black or gray 21/2" square. Sew rows together to make Churn Dash Block. Make 12 total.



Assembling the Quilt Top


Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps.

4 Sew 5 sashing rows of 4 fuchsia squares and 3 gray 101/2" strips each. Sew 4 block rows of 4 gray strips and 3 blocks each. Sew rows together, alternating.

5 Stitch black 54" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch black 66" strips to top/ bottom; trim even with sides.

Quilting and Finishing

6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with black solid.
