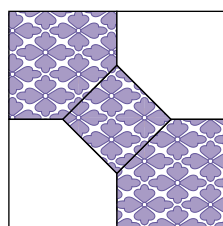
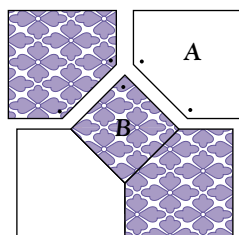


Planning

Mini bow tie blocks stitch up quickly, and make the most of your fabric scrap bag. This quilt does on feedsack prints from the 1930s, but any fabrics will do.

Fabric Requirements

Assorted prints (blocks)	6½ yds. total
White solid (blocks, binding)	5½ yds.
Backing (piece widthwise)	7¾ yds.
Batting size	90" x 100"



Make 810 total
Diagram I

Cutting Instructions (cut in order listed)

Assorted prints—cut **810 matching sets of:**

- 2 Template A
- 1 Template B

White solid

- 10 strips 2½" x width of fabric (binding)
- 1,620 Template A

Piecing the Blocks

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, align match points. Stitch together matching print fabrics (2 Template A and 1 Template B) and 2 white solid Template A fabrics to complete Bow Tie Block. Make 810 total.

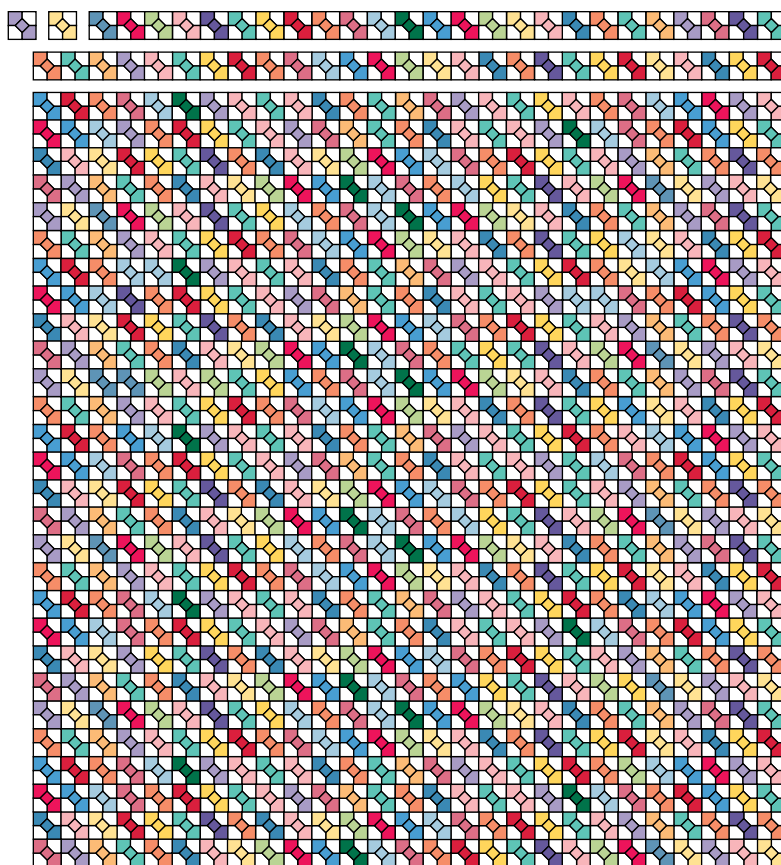
Assembling the Quilt Top

2 Referring to **Assembly Diagram**, sew 30 rows of 27 Bow Tie Blocks each. Stitch rows together.

Quilting and Finishing

3 Layer, baste, and quilt. The quiltmaker hand outline quilted each bow tie and the white solid templates.

4 Bind quilt with white solid.
