24 Hourglass Blocks $63 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 63 / 4^{\prime \prime}$

Assorted green prints, pink prints, and cream prints (blocks)
Cream/white print (inner border)
Pink large floral (outer border)
Pink/green plaid (bias-cut binding)
Backing (piece widthwise)
Batting size
*A fat quarter is an 18 " $\times 20-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric.

## cut

*Assorted green prints, pink prints, and cream prints-cut
from each fat quarter:
3 strips $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 20-22^{\prime \prime}$
2 squares $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$
Cream/white print
4 strips $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 58^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 6 width of fabric strips
Pink large floral
4 strips 6" x 64", cut on lengthwise grain
**Pink/green plaid
1 square $26^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ (for $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide bias-cut binding)

sew
1 Referring to Diagram I, sew 3 assorted 23/4" strips together to make strip set. Make 12 total. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 72 segments $23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ wide. Referring to Diagram II, make NinePatch Block using 3 segments. Make 24 total.


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2 Draw 2 diagonal lines on wrong side of assorted 8" square. Referring to Diagram III, place marked square on different assorted 8 " square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of one line. Cutting on unsewn line first, then on remaining drawn line, cut sewn square into quarters. Press open to make pieced triangles. Make 48 total. Sew together 2 different pieced triangles to make Hourglass Block (Diagram IV). Make 24 total.

3 Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. Sew 8 block rows using 3 Nine-Patch Blocks and 3 Hourglass Blocks each, alternating. Stitch rows together, alternating direction.

4 Sew cream/white print 58" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining cream strips to top/ bottom; trim even with sides. Sew pink large floral 64" strips to sides; trim even.

Stitch remaining floral strips to top/ bottom; trim even.

5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with bias-cut pink/green plaid.
