

Here's how to make Doris's **Bitty Pumpkins**. They finish at 4" x 4" (4-1/2" unfinished).



### Materials and Cutting

#### Orange (pumpkin)

1 square 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

#### Green (stem)

1 square 1" x 1"

#### Cream (background)

1 rectangle 1" x 3-1/2"


2 rectangles 1" x 1-3/4"

4 squares 1" x 1"

1 rectangle 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"

### Sewing

Make the stem:



Use Stitch-and-Flip to make the pumpkin: Put a 1" background square on all 4 corners.



Sew across diagonally. Trim off, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Open out and press.



Sew the stem and the pumpkin together.



Sew a 1" strip to the top and a 1-1/2" strip to the side as shown below. Done!  
Should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" at this point.
