## Broken Star

This is a lovely example of a mid-20th century Broken Star quilt from the IQSC. We sized it up a bit from the original quilt to make it bed-size.


## Finished Size:

72½" $\times 87^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

$31 / 2$ yards yellow solid
2 $1 / 4$ yards green solid
11/4 yard white solid
11/4 yards blue solid
1 yard pink solid
$3 / 8$ yard white print
63/4 yards backing fabric
Full-size quilt batting

## CUTTING

Measurements include $1 / 4^{4}$ seam allowances. Pattern for Diamond is on page 4.

NOTE: Refer to Strip Set Diagrams to cut strip set segments. Cut left end of each strip set at $45^{\circ}$ angle. From strip sets, cut required number of ( 2 "-wide) segments by placing 2 " line on ruler along angled cut edge.

## FROM YELLOW SOLID, CUT:

- 7 (11 $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$-wide) strips. From strips, cut 20 (111/8") A squares.
- 1 ( $161 / 4$ "-wide) strip. From strip, cut $2\left(16^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares. Cut squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 8 quartersquare B triangles
- $6\left(25 / 8^{\prime \prime}-w i d e\right)$ strips. From strips, cut 80 ( $25 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ ) C squares.
- 3 ( $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " -wide) strips. From strips, cut 20 (4¼") squares. Cut squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 80 quartersquare D triangles.


## FROM GREEN SOLID, CUT:

- 17 (2"-wide) strips. From 4 strips, cut 40 Diamonds. Remaining strips are for strip sets.
- 9 ( $41 / 2$ "-wide) strips for binding. NOTE: Binding on this quilt is 1 "-wide.

FROM WHITE SOLID, CUT:

- 21 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.


## FROM BLUE SOLID, CUT:

- 21 (2"-wide) strips. From 5 strips, cut 64 Diamonds. Remaining strips are for strip sets.


## FROM PINK SOLID, CUT:

- 15 (2"-wide) strips. From 5 strips, cut 56 Diamonds. Remaining strips are for strip sets.

FROM WHITE PRINT, CUT:

- 5 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.


## PIECED DIAMOND ASSEMBLY

1. Join 1 white print strip, 1 pink strip, 1 blue strip, 1 white strip, and 1 green strip, offsetting strips about 2" as shown in Strip Set \#1 Diagram. Make 5 Strip Set \#1.
From strip sets, cut 64 (2"-wide) segments.
2. Join 1 pink strip, 1 blue strip, 2 white strips, and 1 green strip, offsetting strips about 2" as shown in Strip Set \#2 Diagram. Make 5 Strip Set \#2. From strip sets, cut 64 ( 2 "-wide) segments.
3. Join 2 blue strips, 2 white strips, and 1 green strip, offsetting strips about 2" as shown in Strip Set \#3 Diagram. Make 3 Strip Set \#3. From strip sets, cut 32 (2"-wide) segments.
4. Join $2 \# 1$ segments, $2 \# 2$ segments, and 1 \#3 segment as shown in Pieced Diamond Diagrams to complete 1 Pieced Diamond. Make 32 Pieced Diamonds.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out 8 pink Diamonds, 4 yellow C squares, and 4 yellow D triangles as shown in Star Diagrams. Join, setting in C squares and D triangles to complete 1 pink Star. Make 7 pink Stars.
2. In the same manner, make 8 blue Stars and 5 green Stars.
3. Lay out 10 Stars as shown in Quilt Top Assembly Diagram. Join Stars make top border. Repeat to make bottom border.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Join 2 Pieced Diamonds as shown in Star Point Diagrams, stitching dot to dot; backstitch at each dot to make 1 Star Point. Make 16 Star Points.
2. Lay out Star Points, yellow A squares, and yellow B triangles as shown in Center Assembly Diagram. Join Star Points. Set in A squares and B triangles to complete Quilt Center.
3. Add borders to complete quilt top.

## FINISHING

1. Divide backing into 3 ( $2^{1 ⁄ 4}$-yard) lengths. Join panels lengthwise
2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired.
3. Join $4 \frac{1}{2}$ "-wide green strips into 1 continuous piece for straightgrain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt. 4
