## Planning and Cutting

Choose your favorite prints in bright colors to make stars that sparkle against the text print background of this delightful runner. The text print is oriented the same direction throughout the project. To achieve this effect our instructions call for cutting text print squares twice diagonally. Keep the quarter-square triangles cut from each square sorted together, so when you construct your blocks each text print triangle can easily be oriented correctly. Handle all bias edges carefully to avoid distortion.

## Fabric Requirements

Text print (background) 5/8 yd.
Assorted bright prints (stars)
Plum chambray (sashing)
Magenta print (binding)
Backing (piece widthwise)
Batting size
\% yd. $3 / 4$ yd. $-11 / 4$ yds. total 5/8 yd. $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$. $11 / 2 \mathrm{yds}$.

## Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)
$\boxtimes=$ cut in half twice diagonally
$\Delta=$ cut in half diagonally
Text print
32 squares $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \boxtimes$
128 squares $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Assorted bright prints-cut 32 matched sets of:

1 square $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 squares $178^{\prime \prime} \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \square$
Plum chambray
16 rectangles $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Magenta print
5 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (binding)

## Piecing the Blocks

(1) Referring to Diagram I, stitch the long side of assorted print $17 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ half-square triangle to short side of text print $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ quarter-square triangle. Open and press. Repeat on remaining side of text triangle to make star point unit. Make 32 sets of 4 matching.

(2) Watching text print orientation, sew 3 rows using 4 text print $1 \frac{112 " \prime}{2}$ squares, 4 matching star point units, and matching assorted print $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square (Diagram II). Stitch rows together to make Small Star Block. Make 32 total.

Referring to Diagram III, sew 2 rows using 4 Small Star Blocks. Stitch rows together to make Multi Star Block. Make 5 total.

Assembling the Table Runner Top (4) Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for this step. Stitch 2 rows using 6 Small Star Blocks and 5 plum chambray $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles each. Sew 1 row using 5 Multi Star Blocks and 6 plum rectangles. Stitch rows together, alternating.

Quilting and Finishing
(5) Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with magenta print.
