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# STONY Crack

Your piecing skills will be rewarded with this stunning quilt.

# MATERIALS ...

# PROJECT RATING: CHALLENGING

**Size:** 71½" x 71½"

**NOTE:** Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the Jinny Beyer Palette and Outback collection by Jinny Beyer for RJR Fabrics.

- 3 yards black stripe for center, inner and outer borders
- % yard turquoise print for middle border
- 3/8 yard each of 7 assorted blue and purple prints ranging in value from light to dark (Group 1)

- ¼ yard each of 7 assorted blue and green prints ranging in value from dark to light (Group 2)
- 3% yard each of 7 assorted turquoise, blue and purple prints ranging in value from light to dark (Group 3)
- 1/4 yard each of 7 assorted green and blue prints ranging in value from light to dark (Group 4)
- ¾ yard black print for binding4½ yards backing fabricFull-size quilt batting

# Cutting

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Patterns for triangles, trapezoid, and parallelograms are on pages 6–21.

#### From black stripe, cut:

• 4 (6"-wide) **lengthwise** strips, centering design in each. From strips, cut 4 (6" x 85") identical outer borders.

- 4 (2"-wide) **lengthwise** strips, centering design in each. From strips, cut 4 (2" x 85") identical inner borders.
- 4 identical G triangles.

#### From turquoise print, cut:

• 9 (3"-wide) strips. Piece strips to make 4 (3" x 85") middle borders.

#### From each fabric in Group 1, cut:

• 6 (1¾"-wide) strips for strip sets.

#### From each fabric in Group 2, cut:

• 2 (2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"-wide) strips for strip sets.

## From each fabric in Group 3, cut:

- 2 (1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"-wide) strips for strip sets.
- 4 (1\%"-wide) strips for strip sets.

## From each fabric in Group 4, cut:

• 4 (1¾"-wide) strips for strip sets.

## From black print, cut:

• 9 (21/4"-wide) strips for binding.

## **Quadrant Assembly**

**1.** Join 1 strip of each print from Group 1 as shown in *Strip Set #1 Diagram*. Make 6 Strip Set #1.

#### Sew Smart<sub>™</sub> /-----

When joining strips for strip sets, alternate sewing direction from strip to strip. This keeps strip sets straight.




Strip Set #1 Diagram



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- 2. From strip sets, cut 4 A triangles and 4 B trapezoids, aligning lines on pattern with seams of strip set as shown in Cutting Diagrams
- **3.** Join 1 strip of each print from Group 2 as shown in Strip Set #2 Diagram. Make 2 Strip Set #2.




Strip Set #2 Diagram

- 4. From each Strip Set #2, cut 2 C parallelograms, aligning lines on pattern with seams of strip set as shown in Cutting Diagrams.
- **5.** Join 1 (1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"-wide) strip of each print from Group 3 as shown in Strip Set #3 Diagram. Make 4 Strip Set #3.




Strip Set #3 Diagram

- **6.** From each Strip Set #3, cut 1 D parallelogram, aligning lines on pattern with seams of strip set as shown in Cutting Diagrams.
- **7.** Join 1 (1¾"-wide) strip of each print from Group 3 as shown in Strip Set #4 Diagram. Make 2 Strip Set #4.




Strip Set #4 Diagram

- **8.** From each Strip Set #4, cut 2 E triangles, aligning lines on pattern with seams of strip set as shown in Cutting Diagrams.
- **9.** Join 1 strip of each print from Group 4 as shown in Strip Set #5 Diagram. Make 4 Strip Set #5.



Strip Set #5 Diagram








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- **10.** From each Strip Set #5, cut 1 F triangle, aligning lines on pattern with seams of strip set, as shown in *Cutting Diagrams*.
- **11.** Lay out 1 of each triangle, parallelogram, and trapezoid as shown in *Quadrant Diagrams*. Join into sections; join sections to complete 1 quadrant. Make 4 quadrants.

## **Border Assembly**

- **1.** Referring to *Quilt Top Assembly Diagram* on page 5, join 1 inner, 1 middle, and 1 outer border, matching centers, to make 1 Border Strip Set.
- 2. Make 4 Border Strip Sets.

## **Quilt Assembly**

- **1.** Lay out quadrants as shown in *Quilt Top Assembly Diagram*. Join to complete quilt center.
- **2.** Add border strip sets to quilt center, mitering corners.

# **Finishing**

**1.** Divide backing into 2 (2½-yard) lengths. Cut 1 piece in half lengthwise

to make 2 narrow panels. Join 1 narrow panel to each side of wider panel; press seam allowances toward narrow panels.

- **2.** Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired.
- **3.** Join 2¼"-wide black print strips into 1 continuous piece for straight-grain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt.



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Quilt Top Assembly Diagram




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
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
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






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
