Note: Appliqué templates (at end of pattern) are printed without seam allowance and include cutting instructions.



Fabric Requirements for Needle Case

Blue floral (outside of case)	5½" x 10" piece
White/pink dot (inside of case)	5" x 9½" piece
Green texture (leaves)	4" x 4" piece
Dark pink print (flower)	5" x 5" piece
Blue texture (flower center)	3" x 3" piece
Pink swirl print (flower center)	2" x 2" piece
Batting	5" x 9½" piece
Pink felt	4" x 7½" piece

Planning

Give appliqué a try with this simple little needle case. Use your favorite appliqué technique or tune in to *McCall's Quilting Fancy Flowers Quilt Along* for fun lessons on how to use hand or machine appliqué to complete this project.



Appliquing the Case

① Fold blue floral 5½" x 10" piece in half widthwise. Referring to **Diagram I**, position A-D in alphabetical order, centering flower on right half of strip and keeping in mind that rectangle will be trimmed to 5" x 9½". Appliqué in place. **Trim** to 5" x 9½".

Finishing the Case

② Referring to **Diagram II**, layer batting, appliquéd rectangle (right side up), and white/pink dot 5" x 9½" rectangle (wrong side up). Stitch around all sides with ¼" seam, leaving opening for turning, (**Diagram III**). Turn right side out and press. Hand stitch opening closed.

③ Center pink felt 4" x 7½" rectangle on inside. Stitch along center line, through all layers (**Diagram IV**).

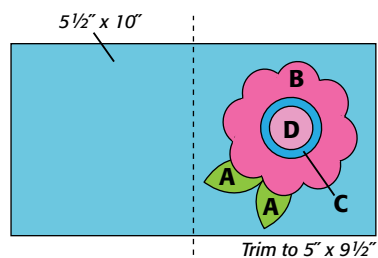

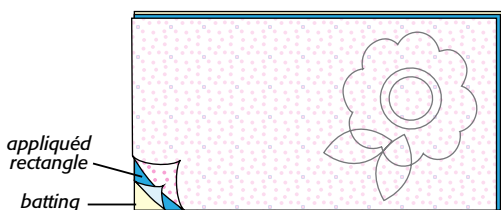

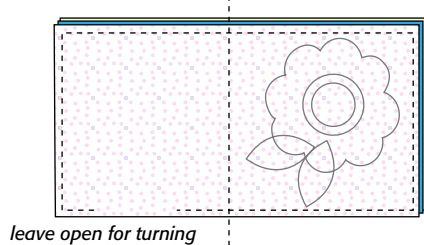

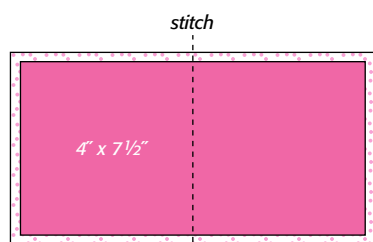
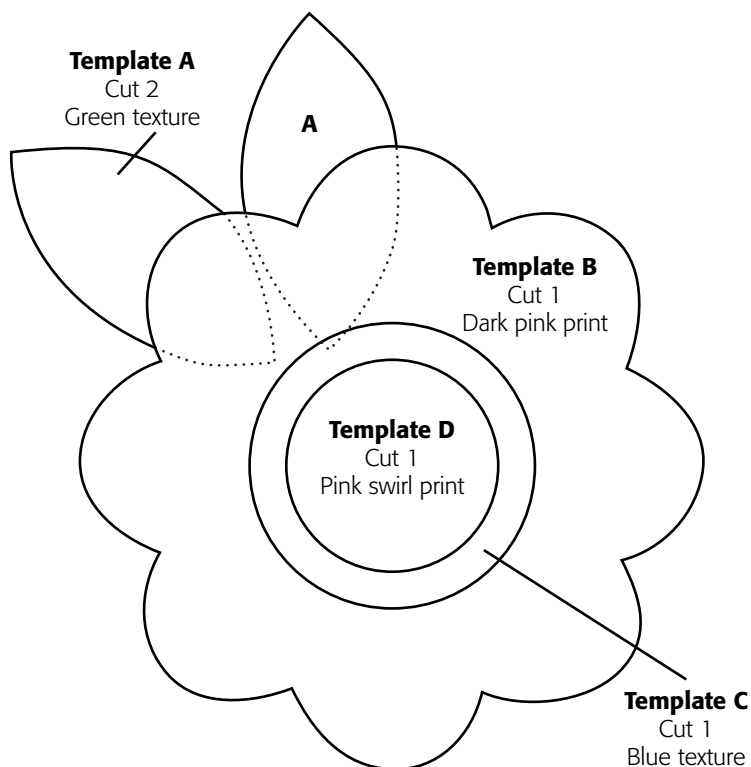
