Garden Path Baby Quilt

Finished Quilt Size
40" x 40"

Number of Blocks & Finished Sizes

3 A Blocks 5" x 8"

2 A Half Blocks 2½" x 8"

4 B Blocks 5" x 9"

3 C Blocks 5" x 8"

2 C Half Blocks 2½" x 8"

Plan

This chic, modern baby quilt design combines a few prints with coordinating solids against a white background. The A Block and A Half Blocks use the same fabrics; the C Block and C Half Blocks are also made with the same fabrics.

The blocks are constructed with rectangles surrounded by thin rectangles cut 1" wide. Pay close attention to color placement of the rectangles as you sew the blocks. Use an accurate ¼" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well.

3 rectangles 1" x 5½"

Gray solid

8 rectangles 1" x 6½"

Pink solid

8 rectangles 1" x 7"

10 rectangles 1" x 5½"

4 rectangles 1" x 3"

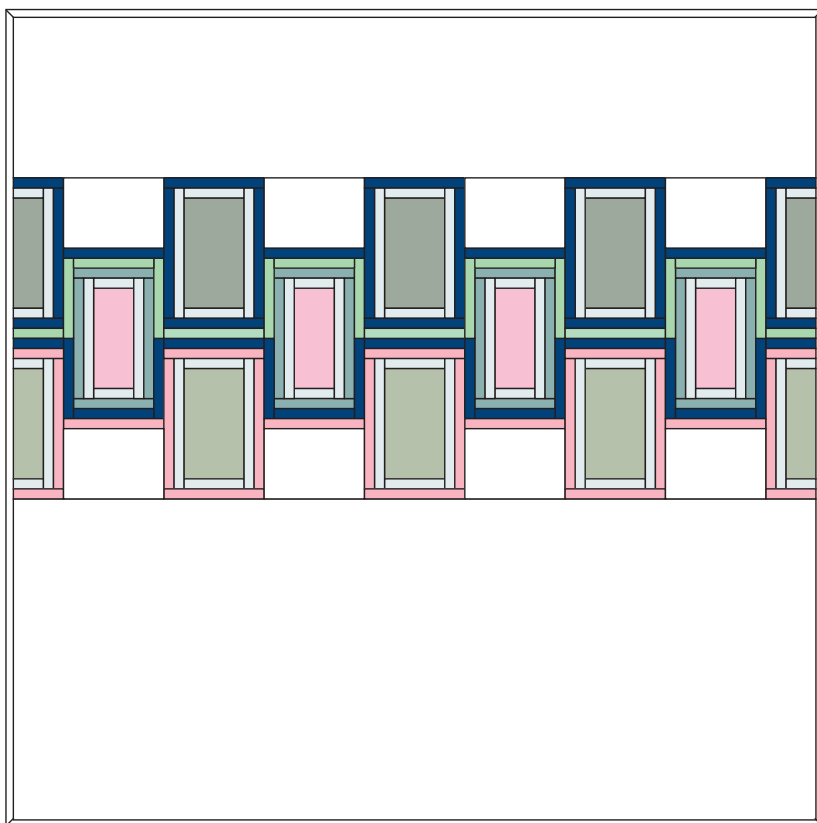

*1 strip 16½" x 40½"

*1 strip 8½" x 40½"

8 rectangles 4" x 5½"

*Border strips are cut to exact length.



Sew

1 Referring to **Diagram I-A**, sew white swirl print $1" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles to top and bottom of gray floral print $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6"$ rectangle. Stitch swirl print $1" \times 7"$ rectangles to sides. Sew navy solid $7"$ rectangles to sides, then sew navy solid $5\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles to top and bottom. Stitch mint solid $5\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle to bottom to make A Block. Make 3.

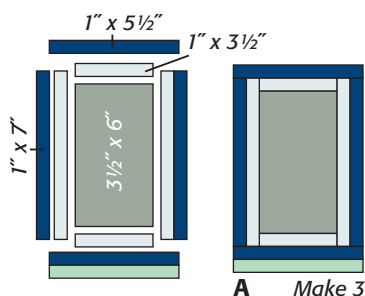
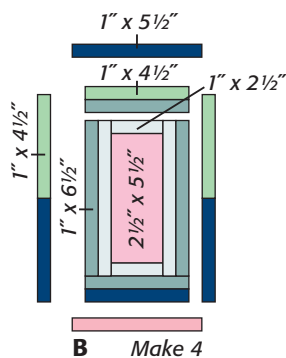
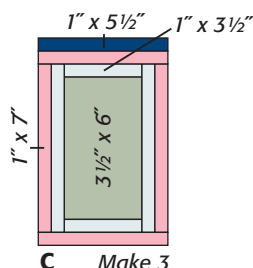

2 In similar manner, referring to **Diagram I-B**, make 4 B Blocks and 3 C Blocks, paying close attention to color placement of rectangles.

3 Make A and C Half Blocks as shown in **Diagram I-C**. AL and CL will be on the left side of the quilt; AR and CR will be on the right.

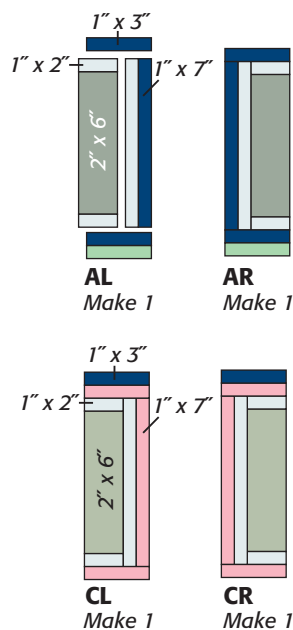


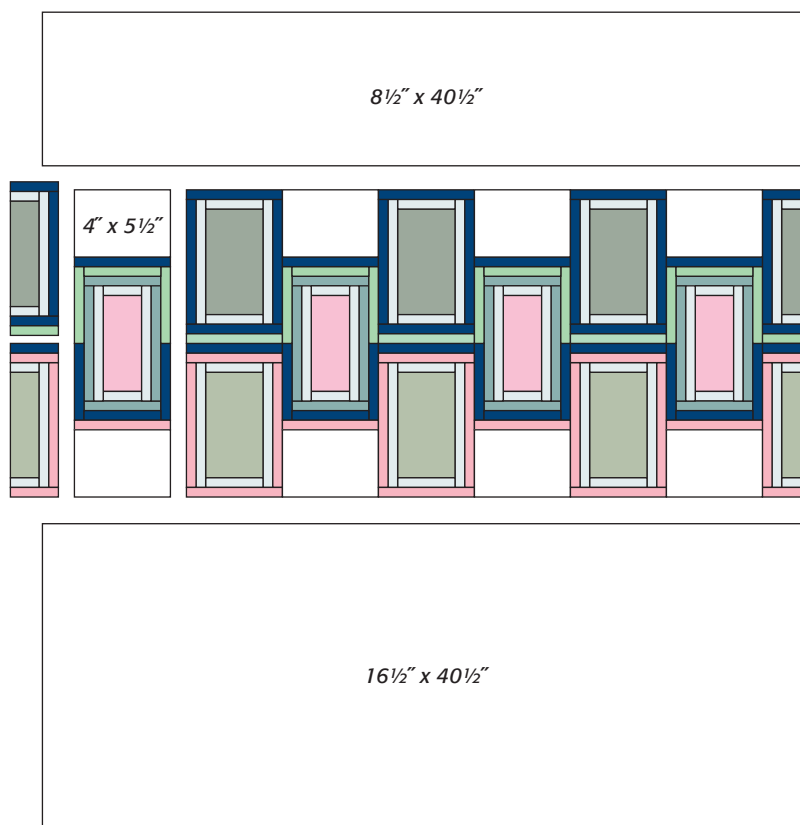

4 Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps, watching block placement and orientation. Sew vertical row using AL and CL. Sew 4 vertical rows using 1 B Block and 2 white solid $4" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangles each. Sew 3 vertical rows using A and C Blocks. Sew vertical row using AR and CR. Stitch rows together as shown.

5 Sew white solid $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 40\frac{1}{2}"$ strip to top. Stitch white $16\frac{1}{2}" \times 40\frac{1}{2}"$ strip to bottom.

6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with white solid.
