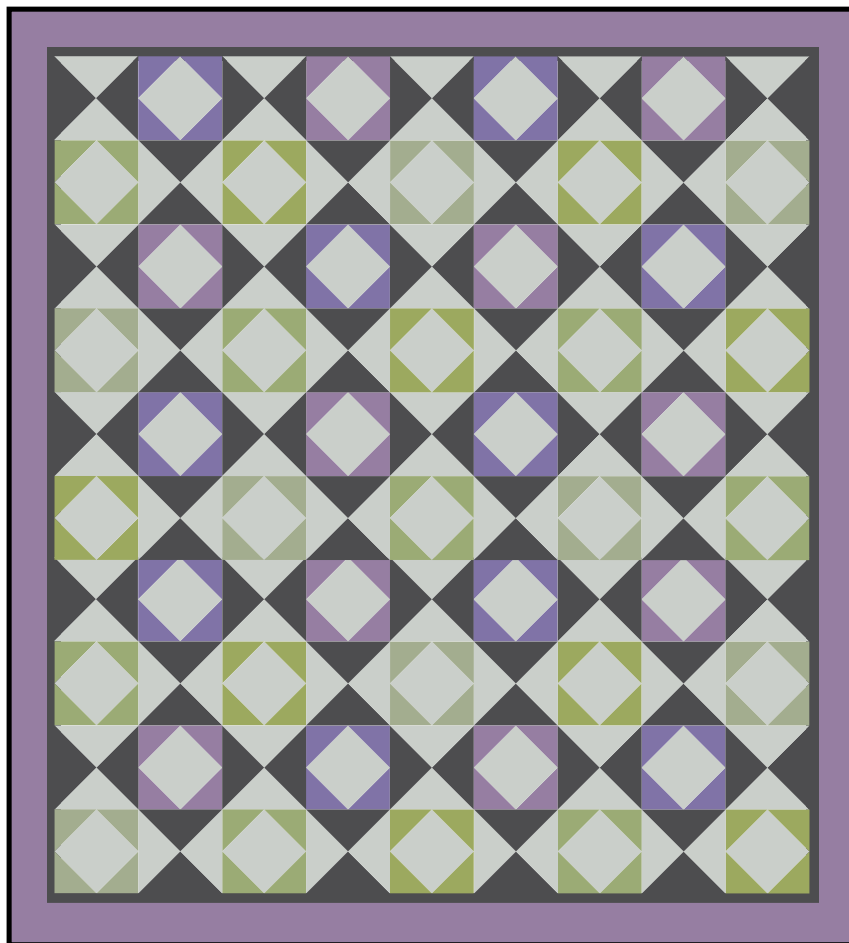
Number of Blocks and Finished Size
45 Hourglass Blocks 9" x 9"
45 Square-in-a-Square Blocks 9" x 9"

Planning

In Tammy's clever design, the repetition of the gray print gives the appearance of blocks set on point. Notice that the placement of the purple and green Square-in-a-Square Blocks enhances that illusion.

Fabric Requirements

Black paisley (blocks, inner border, binding)	3 1/4 yds.*
Gray print (blocks)	3 3/4 yds.
Assorted purple prints (Square-in-a-Square Blocks)	1 1/4-1 1/2 yds.

Assorted green prints (Square-in-a-Square Blocks)	1 1/2-1 3/4 yds.
total	
Purple paisley (outer border)	1 3/8 yds.
Backing (piece widthwise)	8 7/8 yds.
Batting size	100" x 108"
*Based on fabric with at least 41" of usable width.	



Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

▣ = cut in half diagonally

Black paisley

*4 strips 1 1/2" x 94", pieced from 10 width of fabric (WOF) strips

11 strips 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)

23 squares 10 1/4" x 10 1/4"

Gray print

23 squares 10 1/4" x 10 1/4"

45 squares 6 7/8" x 6 7/8"

Assorted purple prints—cut 20 sets of:

2 matching squares 5 3/8" x 5 3/8" ▣

Assorted green prints—cut 25 sets of:

2 matching squares 5 3/8" x 5 3/8" ▣

Purple large paisley

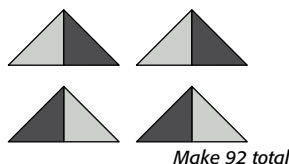
4 strips 4 1/4" x 96", pieced from

10 WOF strips

*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

Piecing the Blocks

1 Draw 2 diagonal lines on wrong side of gray print $10\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Referring to **Diagram I-A**, place marked square on black paisley $10\frac{1}{4}$ " square, right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of one line. Cutting on unsewn line first, then on remaining drawn line, cut sewn square into quarters. Open and press to make 4 pieced triangles. Make 92 total. Referring to **Diagram I-B**, stitch 2 pieced triangles together to make Hourglass Block. Make 45. You'll have 2 pieced triangles left over.

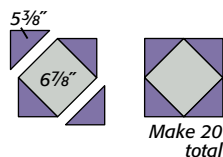

2 Referring to **Diagram II**, sew 4 matching purple $5\frac{3}{8}$ " half-square triangles to gray $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square to make Square-in-a-Square Block. Make 20 total purple and 25 total green blocks.

Assembling the Quilt Top

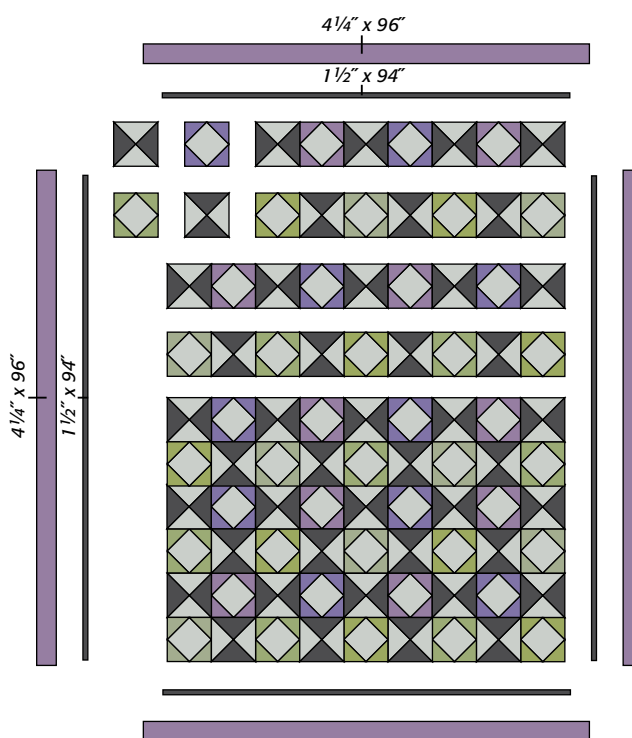
Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps, watching placement and orientation of blocks.

3 Sew 10 rows of 9 blocks each. Sew rows together.

4 Stitch black paisley 94" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Sew black 94" strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides. Sew purple large paisley 96" strips to sides; trim even. Stitch remaining purple strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

Quilting and Finishing

5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with black paisley.
