# Lititle Bits of History Web Bonus: Brídle Path Variation Block 

Finished Block Size
$12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Instructions

Red small floral 6 squares 2" x $2^{\prime \prime}$
Green print
*1 strip 2" x $20^{\prime \prime}$
2 squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
Yellow print
*1 strip 2" x 20"
4 squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
Light pink print and cream/pink floral-cut from each:

2 squares 2" x $2^{\prime \prime}$
Blue print and medium pink
print-cut from each:
4 squares $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Piecing the Block
(1) Sew 4 rows of four 2" squares each in fabrics shown
(Diagram I). Sew rows together to make block center.

(2) Stitch together yellow print and green print $2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strips (Diagram II-A). Press seam in direction of arrow. Cut 8 segments 2 " wide.

Referring to Diagram II-B, sew 2 segments together to make block corner. Make 4.

(3) Draw diagonal line on wrong side of medium pink print $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place marked square on blue print $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together (Diagram III-A). Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Press open to make pieced squares. Make 8.


4 Referring to Diagram IV, make Bridle Path Variation Block.

Sew 2 pieced squares together, watching orientation, to make pieced rectangle (Diagram III-B). Make 4.
