## Fabric Requirements

White texture (block backgrounds)
Red texture (blocks)
Green print (setting squares and triangles)
White/red/green print (inner border)
Poinsettia print (outer border)
Green texture (binding)
Backing (piece widthwise)
Batting size
7/8 yd.
5/8 yd.
$11 / 2 \mathrm{yds}$.
5/8 yd.
13/4 yds.
$3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$.
$35 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$.
$64^{\prime \prime} \times 76^{\prime \prime}$

## Planning

The cozy, Christmas-y lap size version of this quilt features seasonal fabrics and fast, easy blocks. Make it in a weekend!

## Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)
$\boxtimes=$ cut in half twice diagonally
$\Delta=$ cut in half diagonally
White texture
24 squares $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
48 squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Red texture
24 squares $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
12 squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Green print
3 squares 15" x 15" $\boxtimes$
6 squares $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
2 squares 8 " $\times 8^{\prime \prime} \boxtimes$
White/red/green print
*4 strips $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 56$ ", pieced from 6 width of fabric (WOF) strips
Poinsettia print
*4 strips $61 / 2$ " $x$ length of fabric (LOF)
Green texture
7 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (binding)
*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Piecing the Blocks

(1) Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white texture $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram I, place marked square on red texture $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 48 .

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Referring to Diagram II, stitch together 4 pieced squares, 4 white $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, and 1 red $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make Shoo Fly Block. Make 12.

## Assembling the Quilt Top

Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. The setting triangles on all edges and corners are cut oversized for subsequent trimming. (3) Arrange and stitch 6 diagonal rows using green print $15^{\prime \prime}$ quarter-square triangles and $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, plus blocks. You will have 2 quarter-square triangles left over. Sew rows together. Stitch green $8^{\prime \prime}$ halfsquare triangles to corners. Trim edges even.

Stitch white/red/green print 56 " strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining white/red/green strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides. Sew poinsettia print LOF strips to sides; trim even. Sew remaining poinsettia print strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

## Quilting and Finishing

(5) Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with green texture.
