Fabric Requirements

White texture (block backgrounds)	7/8 yd.
Red texture (blocks)	5/8 yd.
Green print (setting squares and triangles)	1 1/2 yds.
White/red/green print (inner border)	5/8 yd.
Poinsettia print (outer border)	1 3/4 yds.
Green texture (binding)	3/4 yd.
Backing (piece widthwise)	3 5/8 yds.
Batting size	64" x 76"

Planning

The cozy, Christmas-y lap size version of this quilt features seasonal fabrics and fast, easy blocks. Make it in a weekend!

Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

☒ = cut in half twice diagonally

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White texture

24 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"

48 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Red texture

24 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"

12 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Green print

3 squares 15" x 15" ☒

6 squares 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"

2 squares 8" x 8" ☒

White/red/green print

*4 strips 2 1/2" x 56", pieced from 6 width of fabric (WOF) strips

Poinsettia print

*4 strips 6 1/2" x length of fabric (LOF)

Green texture

7 strips 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)

*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

Piecing the Blocks

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white texture $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Referring to **Diagram I**, place marked square on red texture $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square, right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 48.

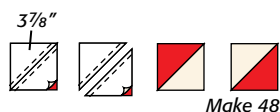

2 Referring to **Diagram II**, stitch together 4 pieced squares, 4 white $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and 1 red $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make Shoo Fly Block. Make 12.

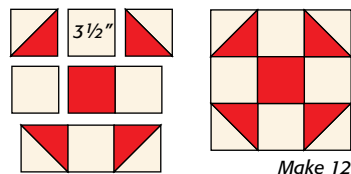

Assembling the Quilt Top

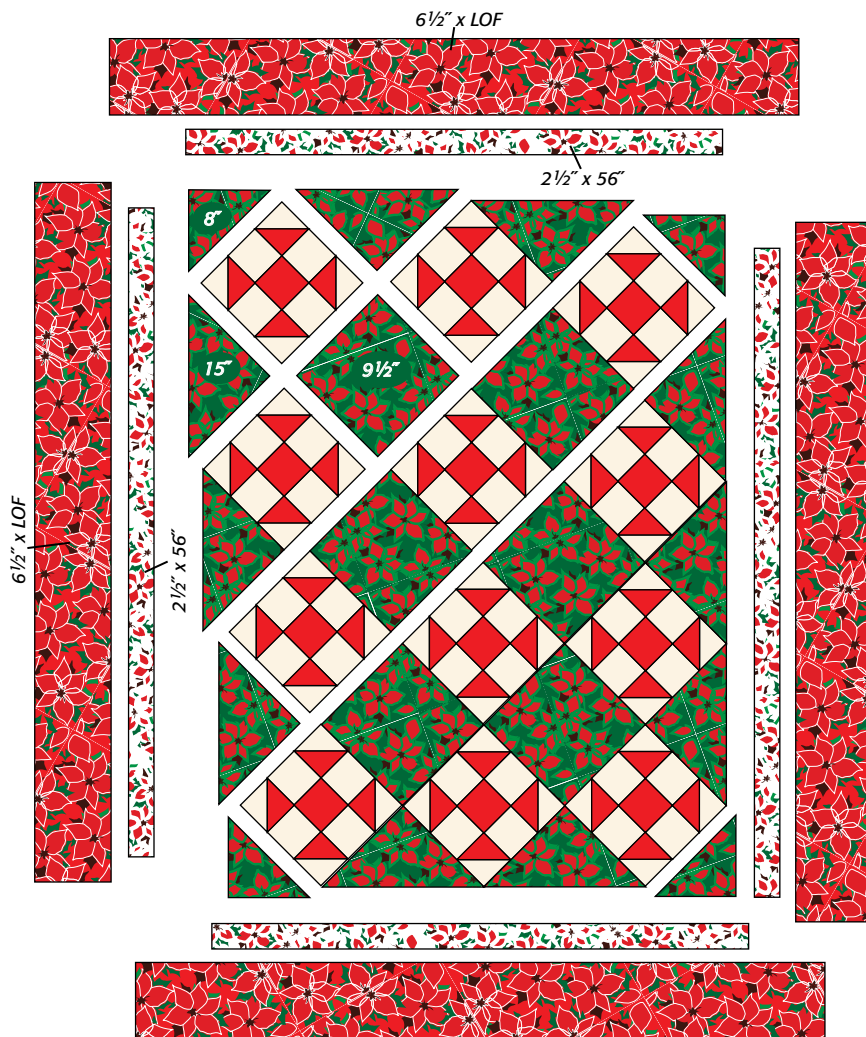
Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps. The setting triangles on all edges and corners are cut oversized for subsequent trimming.

3 Arrange and stitch 6 diagonal rows using green print 15" quarter-square triangles and $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, plus blocks. You will have 2 quarter-square triangles left over. Sew rows together. Stitch green 8" half-square triangles to corners. **Trim** edges even.

4 Stitch white/red/green print 56" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining white/red/green strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides. Sew poinsettia print LOF strips to sides; trim even. Sew remaining poinsettia print strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

Quilting and Finishing

5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with green texture.
