## Posh Tot Baby Changing Pad

Designed and Machine Quilted by JOYCE ROBINSON

**CONFIDENT BEGINNER**

**Finished Changing Pad Size**  
16½" x 34½"

### Fabric Requirements

|  |                      |
|--|----------------------|
| Assorted gray, orange, white/black,<br>and light brown prints (quilt center) | ¾-1 yd. <b>total</b> |
| White solid (border, binding)  | ½ yd.                |
| Tan solid (border)   | ⅛ yd.                |
| Backing  | ¾ yd.                |
| Batting size   | 24" x 42"            |

### Planning

This soft and gentle changing table quilt makes a thoughtful gift for new parents, and will enhance any modern nursery. Choose a harmonious blend of prints in a range of values (lights, mediums, and darks) to duplicate the sophisticated look. Use a design wall or other flat surface to arrange your assorted print squares into a pleasing, balanced arrangement before sewing.

### Cutting Instructions

Assorted gray, orange, white/black, and light brown prints—**cut a total of:**

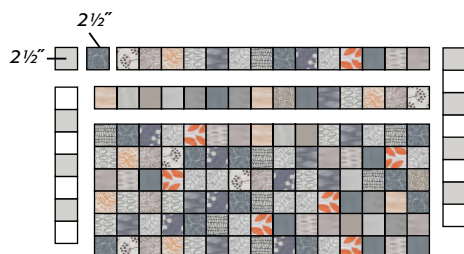
- 120 squares 2½" x 2½"
- White solid
  - 3 strips 2½" x width of fabric (binding)
  - 8 squares 2½" x 2½"
- Tan solid
  - 8 squares 2½" x 2½"



### Piecing and Assembling the Changing Pad

**Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps.

- 1 Sew together 15 assorted print 2½" squares to make row. Make 8. Sew rows together to make center.



**Assembly Diagram**

- 2 Sew together 4 tan and 4 white 2½" squares, alternating, to make side border. Make 2. Sew to center.

### Quilting and Finishing

- 3 Layer, baste, and quilt. Joyce machine quilted an all over meandering loop design in a contrasting thread. Bind with white solid.
