

## Cutting Instructions

(in order listed)
White dot
2 squares 47/8" x 47/8"
1 strip $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$
Purple texture
2 squares $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Lavender dot
1 strip $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$
Black dot
1 square $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Propeller Block

SKILL LEVEL BEGINNER

Finished Block Size
$10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$

## Making the Block

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white dot $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place marked square on purple 47/8" square, right sides together (Diagram I). Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 4.

2 Referring to Diagram II, sew together white and lavender $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make strip set. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 4 segments $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ wide.


3 Referring to Diagram III, sew 3 rows using 4 pieced squares, 4 segments, and black $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew rows together to make Propeller Block.
