

Sketchbook Slipcover

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Materials

- Sketchbook or composition book
- Enough cloth to wrap the book like a present
- The same amount of batting
- The same amount of material for the inside lining of the sketchbook cover, plus 8"

Instructions

- Create the cover cloth by piecing, painting, or embellishing with your favorite creative method.
- Layer the quilt top with the batting (no backing needed) and complete all of the machine quilting, hand stitching, and embellishing.
- 3. Place the inside lining fabric wrong side up on the work surface and then place the quilt on top of it.

- 4. Place the book on 1 side, leaving a ½" seam allowance and trace around 3 sides of the book, not the spine.
- 5. Stand the book up onto its spine, carefully place it down onto the other side, and finish tracing.
- **6.** Trim these 2 layers to ½" outside of the drawn line.
- Remove the inside lining fabric layer and place it face down on top of the quilt. Fold just the lining in half then



- cut it down the middle and finger press a 1"-2" flap from the center.
- **8.** Cut a strip of cloth wide enough to cover the center flaps and place it on top of them. (Figure 1)
- 9. Sew all the way around the edges with a ¹/₄" seam allowance.
- **10.** Trim the corners and turn the book cover inside out.

- 11. Work the edges with your fingers until they are straight and tight.
- 12. Edgestitch all the way around.
- **13.** Carefully open the book until it is almost inside out, insert the covers into the sleeves, and gently work them all the way in. ■
