

# **Baby House Block**

Cozy little cottage

### materials

Finished Block: 5"

**Assorted Scraps** 5 fabrics for each block


## cutting


#### **Roof Fabric** 1 rectangle (A) 11/2" x 51/2" **Background Fabric** 5 squares (B) 11/2" x 11/2" **Chimney Fabric** 2 squares (B) 11/2" x 11/2" **Door Fabric** 1 rectangle (C) 11/2" x 21/2" House Fabric 1 square (B) 11/2" x 11/2" 1 square (D) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" 1 rectangle (E) 11/2" x 31/2"

#### Making the Block

Use the stitch and flip method to create the (roof) unit: Place a B background patch at one end of A, right sides together. Mark and sew diagonally across B as shown. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4", open out the B patch and press. Repeat on the other end as shown to complete the unit.

Join the patches with the unit as shown to complete the block.







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
