## Web Bonus: Rosy Lullaby Twin Size

Adapted from a Quilt Designed by MELISSA CORRY

## Finished Quilt Size

60 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 901 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Shop

White/red dot,
tan/red small floral,
and pink small floral (piecing) 1 yd. each

Bright pink floral, red/white floral, pink/white floral, and red floral (piecing)

Tan large floral (piecing, binding) Backing (piece lengthwise) Batting size


The pattern for the baby quilt size of Melissa's design is in the October/November 2012 issue of McCall's Quick Quilts.

## Sew

(1) Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white/red dot $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram I-A, place marked square on tan/red small floral $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 14.

Referring to Diagram I-B, make remaining pieced squares in fabric combinations and quantities shown.

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Referring to Diagram II, sew together tan/red small floral and pink small floral WOF strips to make strip set. Make 4. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 52 segments 3 " wide. In same manner, make remaining strip sets and cut segments in fabric combinations and quantities shown.

Sew 2 matching segments together to make 4-patch (Diagram III). Make 108 total in fabric combinations and quantities shown.

4) Referring to Assembly Diagram and watching fabric placement, arrange and sew 18 rows of 6 pieced squares and six 4-patches each. You will have 2 pieced squares left over. Stitch rows together.
(5) Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with tan large floral.
