# seweasy <br> <br> Three-Color Hourglass Units 

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Try our quick and easy method to make Hourglass Units without cutting triangles.
The Fons \& Porter Quarter Inch Seam Marker helps you draw stitching lines quickly.

1. From 2 different fabrics (pink and cream), cut 1 square $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " larger than the desired finished size of the Hourglass Unit. For example, to make Hourglass Units that will finish $1^{1 / 2} /$ as in Root Beer $\mathcal{E}$ Bubblegum, cut $23 / 4$ " squares.
2. On wrong side of 1 square, place Quarter Inch Seam Marker diagonally across square, with

yellow center line positioned exactly at corners. Mark stitching guidelines along both sides of Quarter Inch Seam Marker (Photo $A$ ).

NOTE: If you are not using the Fons \& Porter Quarter Inch Seam Marker, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner across square. Then draw sewing lines on each side of the first line $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away.
