

# Web Bonus: Scent of Spring Queen Size

Adapted from a Quilt Designed by  
**Maria Umhey**

**Note:** Appliqué templates (at end of pattern) are printed reversed and without seam allowances (except bottoms of stems) to use with paper-backed fusible web.

Finished Quilt Size  
85¼" x 97¾"

Number of Blocks and Finished Size  
143 Rail Fence Blocks 6¼" x 6¼"



- **Note:** To make the queen size version of this quilt, patterned here, you will need **2 kits**. Each kit of fabrics for quilt top and binding (available while supplies last) is \$89.99 (#QQ120502). Call **877-269-8024**, or shop online at [ShopMcCallsQuilting.com](http://ShopMcCallsQuilting.com).

- **Note:** For the queen size version of this quilt, you will need **2 backings**. Each backing is \$49.99 (#QQ120502B).



The lap size (66½" x 72¾") version of this quilt is patterned in the April/May 2012 issue of *McCall's Quick Quilts*.

## Plan

Lovely prints from the California Girl collection by Fig Tree Quilts for Moda give this sweet quilt its soft elegance. For this pattern, fat quarters must measure at least 18" x 21". If your fat quarters are smaller than this, you may need more fabric.

The pale blue print, dark blue small print, and coral small floral (border and binding fabrics) may also be used in block fabrics; cut border and binding strips first, then 1 3/4" x 21-22" strips as desired.

## Shop

15 assorted light prints/solids <b>and</b> 15 assorted dark prints/solids (blocks)	1 fat quarter* <b>each</b>
Pale blue print (inner border)	3/4 yd.
Dark blue small print (outer border)	1 3/4 yds.
Green stripe (stems, leaves)	1/4 yd.
Coral small floral (flowers, binding)	1 3/8 yds.
Paper-backed fusible web	1 1/2 yds.
Backing (piece widthwise)	8 yds.
Batting size	94" x 106"

\*A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric; see **Plan**.

## Cut

(first, and in order listed)

**Note:** Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at end of pattern.

15 assorted light prints/solids **and** 15 assorted dark prints/solids—**cut from each:**

8 strips 1 3/4" x 21-22"

Pale blue print

\*4 strips 2 1/2" x 86", pieced from 9 width of fabric (WOF) strips

Dark blue small print

\*4 strips 6 1/2" x 90", pieced from 9 WOF strips

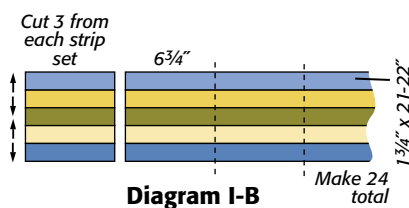
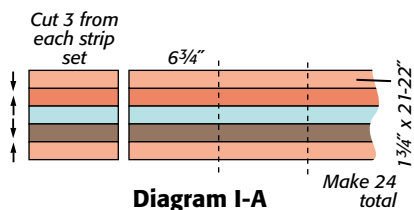
Coral small floral

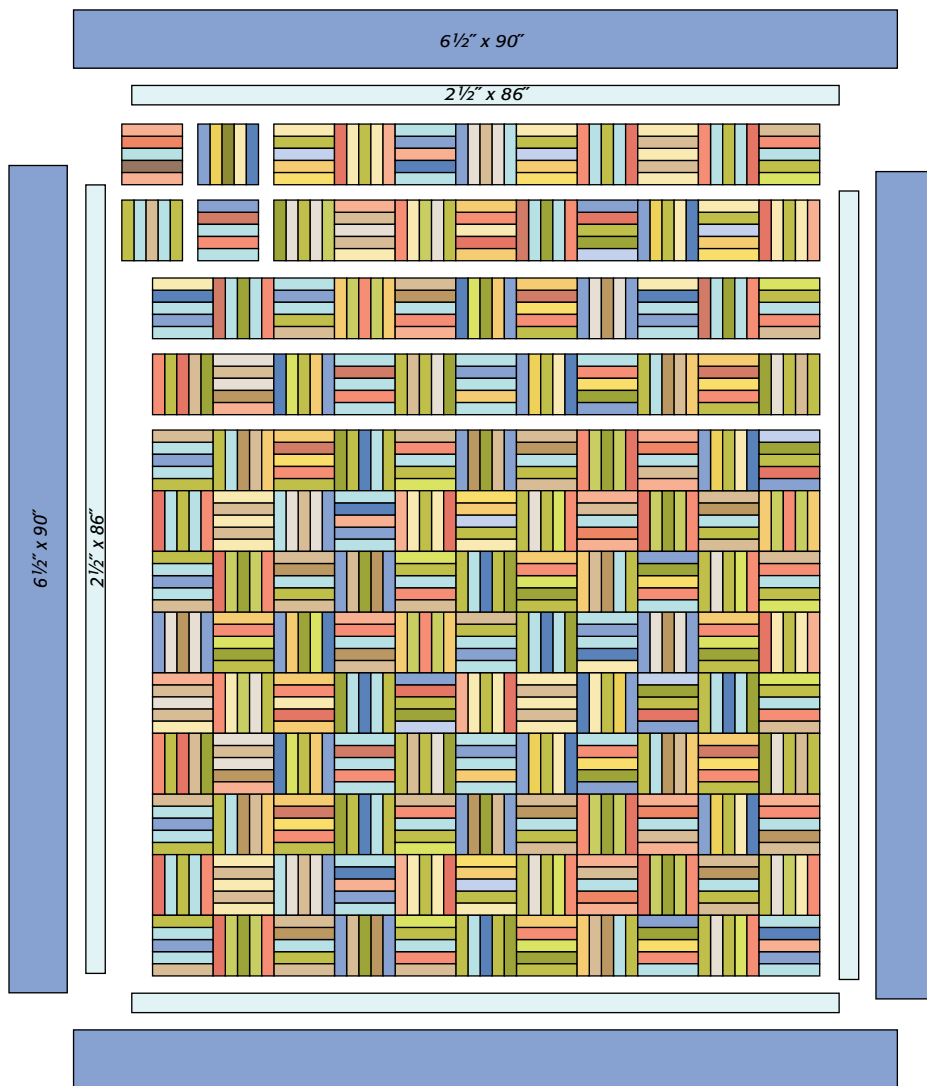
11 strips 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)

\*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Sew

1 Referring to **Diagram I-A**, sew together 3 assorted light and 2 assorted dark 21-22" strips, alternating, to make strip set. Make 24 total. Press in direction of arrows. Cut 3 Rail Fence Blocks 6 3/4" wide from each strip set. In same manner, use 3 assorted dark and 2 assorted light strips to make strip set (**Diagram I-B**). Make 24 total. Press, and cut each into 3 blocks 6 3/4" wide.





Assembly Diagram

- 2 **Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps. Watching placement and orientation, sew 13 rows of 11 blocks each, alternating. You will have 1 block left over. Sew rows together.
- 3 Stitch pale blue print 86" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining pale blue strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides. Sew dark blue small print 90" strips to sides; trim even. Sew remaining dark blue strips to top/bottom; trim even.
- 4 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-F on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines. Finger-press bottom border of quilt in half (**Diagram II**); use fold as placement guide. Position A-F as shown. Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine zigzag stitch (**Diagram III**). Repeat to add appliqué to remaining 3 sides of quilt.
- 5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with coral small floral.

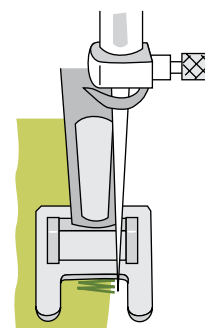

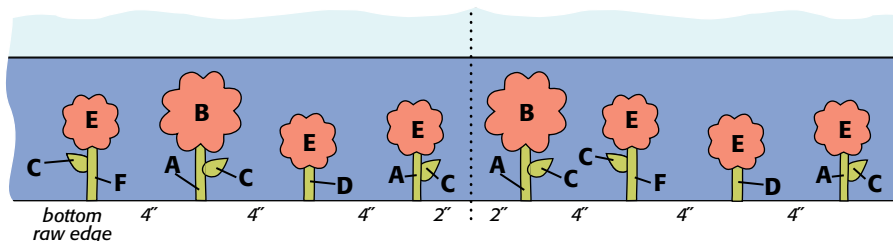
