

# Web Bonus: S'mittens Table Runner

Finished Table Runner Size 213/4" x 471/4"

Number of Blocks and Finished Size 3 S'mittens Blocks 9" x 9"

Note: Appliqué templates (at end of pattern) are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

# Shop

Cream print (block backgrounds) 3/8 yd. Assorted red, green, and gold prints (mittens, cuffs) 3/8-5/8 yd. total 5/8 yd. Green print (setting triangles) Gold stripe (inner border) 3/8 yd. Red print (outer border) 3/4 yd. Green holly print (binding) 3/8 yd. Paper-backed fusible web 3/4 yd. Backing 15/8 yds. 28" x 54" Batting size



#### Plan

Welcome guests this winter with this super cute holiday mitten table runner. Each block has 2 pairs of matching mittens; do likewise if you wish or make every mitten different for a more scrappy look. Erin used hand appliqué to create her blocks. Our instructions are for fusible appliqué.

### Cut

#### (in order listed)

**Note:** Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at the end of pattern.

 $\boxtimes$  = cut in half twice diagonally

 $\square$  = cut in half diagonally

Cream print

3 squares 91/2" x 91/2"

Green print

1 square 15" x 15" ⊠

2 squares 9" x 9" □

Gold stripe

\*2 strips 11/2" x 44", pieced from 3 width of fabric (WOF) strips

\*2 strips 11/2" x 20"

Red print

\*2 strips 3<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 46", pieced from 3 WOF strips

\*2 strips 33/4" x 26"

Green holly print

4 strips 2½" x WOF (binding)

\*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Sew

1 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-B on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines.

Finger-press cream print 91/2" square in half on both diagonals; use folds as placement guide. Position A-B in alphabetical order (**Diagram I**). Fuse in place to make S'mittens Block. Make 3 total.




Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch (**Diagram II**).




- 2 Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for the following steps. The setting triangles on all edges and corners are cut oversized for subsequent trimming. Arrange and sew 3 diagonal rows using green print 15" quarter-square triangles and blocks. Sew rows together. Sew green 9" half-square triangles to corners. Trim edges even.
- **3** Sew gold stripe 44" strips to long sides; trim even with short sides. Sew gold stripe 20" strips to short sides; trim even with long sides. Sew red print 46" strips to long sides; trim even. Sew red print 26" strips to short sides; trim even.
- 4 Layer, baste, and quilt. Karen machine quilted loops in the block backgrounds using cream thread. A holly motif is quilted in the setting triangles and border using matching thread. Bind with green holly print.


