


Web Bonus: Stars for Sydney Bed Size Patriotic



Adapted from a Quilt Designed by Debbie Taylor for It's Sew Emma

Finished Ouilt Size 841/2" x 961/2"

Number of Blocks and Finished Size 28 Nine-Patch Blocks 12" x 12" 28 Star Blocks 12" x 12"

Note: Star template, given reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web, is at end of pattern.

Shop

Assorted blue prints (blocks) Assorted white prints (backgrounds) Assorted red prints (blocks) Red/white/blue stripe (bias-cut binding) Paper-backed fusible web Backing (piece widthwise) Batting size

3-4 yds. total 51/2-6 yds. total 3-4 yds. total 1 yd. 83⁄4 yds. 81/8 yds. 94" x 106"

Plan

Easy nine-patches and fused stars make this a super-fast bed guilt. Gather up your red, white, and blue scrap fabrics and get started today!

Cut

(in order listed, before cutting stars)

Note: Cutting instructions for stars are on template at end of pattern. Assorted blue prints-cut 14 sets of: 5 matching squares 41/2" x 41/2" Assorted white prints

cut 28 sets of:

4 matching squares 41/2" x 41/2"

cut a total of:

28 squares 121/2" x 121/2" Assorted red prints-cut 14 sets of:

5 matching squares 41/2" x 41/2"

Red/white/blue stripe

1 bias-cut strip 21/2" x 372" (from 1 square 32" x 32"*) *For help, visit QuickQuilts.com and click on Lessons and then Continuous Bias.



Sew


Using 5 matching blue and 4 matching white 4¹/₂" squares, sew 3 rows of 3 squares each (Diagram I-A). Sew rows together to make blue Nine-Patch Block. Make 14 total. In similar manner, make 14 total red Nine-Patch Blocks (Diagram I-B).

AcCall's UILTING

- 2 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paperbacked fusible web. Trace Template A shapes on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines. Finger-press white 12½" square in half on both length and width; use folds as placement guide. Position A (Diagram II-A). Fuse in place. Make 14 total. In same manner, make 14 blue star squares as shown in Diagram II-B. Edge-stitch stars using machine blanket stitch (Diagram III) to complete 28 total Star Blocks.
- **3** Referring to the **Assembly Diagram**, sew 8 rows of 7 blocks each, alternating. Sew rows together.
- 4 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with bias-cut red/ white/blue stripe.
