## Web Bonus: <br> Sweater Weather Bed Runner

Adapted from a Quilt Designed by BEA LEE

Finished Bed Runner Size
$26 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Planning

Bea's inspiration for this knit-look design was a favorite ski sweater! She pieced the larger throw quilt square by square to mimic the look of a knitted piece, using an AccuQuilt ${ }^{\circledR}$ die to cut the squares. Our pattern uses strip set construction to speed the sewing. The bed runner top is assembled in 3 horizontal sections, 2 A and 1 center section $B$. Be sure to use an accurate $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance throughout so your rows and columns line up well.

## Fabric Requirements

Navy solid (piecing, binding)
Light blue solid, red solid, and white solid

## (piecing)

Backing
Batting size
$5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. each $21 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$. $36^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Instructions

Navy solid

* 15 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (WOF)
Light blue solid, red solid, and white solid-cut from each:
7 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
*Set aside 5 strips for binding.


## Piecing the Segments

(1) For A sections, refer to Diagram I and sew together 2 navy and 2 light blue WOF strips to make strip set. Make 2. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 32 segments $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ wide. In same manner, make remaining A section strip sets, press, and cut segments as shown.

In same manner, refer to Diagram II to make strip sets, press, and cut segments for section B.

Assembling the Quilt Top

Sew together 31 segments as shown to make section A. Make 2.
4) In same manner, make section B.

## Quilting and Finishing

(6) Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with navy solid.
