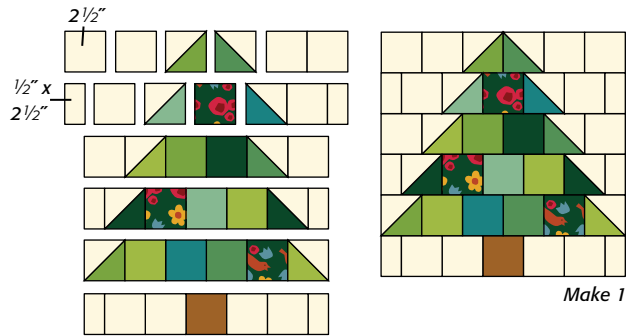
## Fabric Requirements

Cream/white print (background)	1 fat quarter*
5 assorted green prints (tree)	8" x 8" piece <b>each</b>
Brown mottle (trunk)	4" x 4" piece
Green/red print (border)	1 fat quarter*
Green mottle (binding)	1 fat quarter*
Backing <b>and</b> batting	22" x 22" piece <b>each</b>
12 red buttons, ½"	
Mini lights garland, 1 yd.	

\*A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

## Planning

This adorable little tree features seasonal embellishments, and is fast enough to stitch up on the night before Christmas! Melinda substituted 2⅞" and 2½" squares cut from the border and binding fabrics for a few of the assorted green squares used in her tree. You will have sufficient yardage to do likewise if you wish; cut border and binding strips first, and then cut squares as desired. Mini lights garland can be found at craft stores, or online at [nationalartcraft.com](http://nationalartcraft.com) (search for "miniature garland").

## Assembling the Quilt Top

**3** Referring to the **Assembly Diagram**, stitch green/red print strips to sides of block; trim even with top and bottom. Stitch remaining green/red strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

## Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

Cream/white print

5 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

12 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

6 rectangles 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

5 assorted green prints—cut from each:

1 square 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Brown mottle

1 square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Green/red print

\*4 strips 2 1/2" x 20-22"

Green mottle

5 strips 2 1/2" x 20-22" (binding)

\*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Piecing the Block

**1** Draw diagonal line on wrong side of cream/white print 2 7/8" square. Place marked square on assorted green 2 7/8" square, right sides together (**Diagram I**). Sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 10 total.



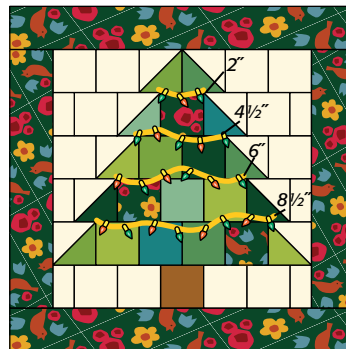

**2** Referring to **Diagram II**, sew 6 rows using cream 2 1/2" squares and 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles, pieced squares, and green and brown 2 1/2" squares. Sew rows together to make 1 Christmas Tree Block.

## Quilting and Finishing

**4** Layer, baste, and quilt. Melinda machine quilted in the ditch along each tree row. She added diagonal lines of stitching to the background, and quilted the border in the ditch. Bind with green mottle.

**5** Referring to **Diagram III** for suggested lengths, cut pieces of mini lights garland and tack to wall hanging. Referring to **quilt photo** for placement, tack buttons to wall hanging.
