# Tulip Time web Bous: Lap Size 



The pattern for the smaller ( $\left.441 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ size of this quilt is in the April/May 2012 issue of McCall's Quick Quilts.

Finished Quilt Size
$561 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 681 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Note: Appliqué templates (at end of pattern) are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

## Plan

Cheryl grew her pretty purple and pink garden using lots of Bali batiks by Hoffman, plus a few scraps from her stash. Be sure to use an accurate $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance throughout construction so the pieced border fits well.

## Cut

(in order listed)
Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at end of pattern.
Assorted purple and pink mottles/ prints-cut a total of:

253 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
White-on-white print
*4 strips $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from
5 width of fabric (WOF) strips
254 squares $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$

Purple dot
7 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (binding)
**2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 4 WOF strips
*2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 3 WOF strips
**2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60$ ", pieced from 3 WOF strips
*2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 3 WOF strips
*2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, pieced from 3 WOF strips
*2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

* Border strips are cut to exact length.
** Border strips include extra length for trimming.

Sew
1 Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. Arrange and sew 12 rows, each using 9 white and 8 assorted purple/pink $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, alternating. Arrange and sew 11 rows, each using 9 assorted purple/pink and 8 white $21 / 2$ " squares, alternating. Sew rows together, alternating.

2 Sew purple dot 461/2" strips to sides. Sew purple $361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to top and bottom. Stitch white $481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides. Stitch white $481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to top/bottom. Sew purple $601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides. Sew purple $501 / 2$ " strips to top/ bottom.

3 Sew together 16 white and 15 purple/pink squares, alternating, to make side pieced border strip. Make 2. Sew to sides of quilt. Sew together 14 purple/pink and 13 white squares, alternating, to make top/bottom pieced border strip. Make 2. Sew to top/ bottom.

4 Sew purple 72" strips to sides; trim even with top/ bottom. Sew purple 60" strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.
5 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-D on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines.


Assembly Diagram


Diagram I

Referring to Diagram I for placement, position 5 tulips along both top and bottom, 7 tulips along each side, and a tulip with a longer stem in each corner. Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch (Diagram II).


Diagram II
6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with purple dot.
