# Two Hearts Placemats

Designed and Machine Quilted by  
**Diane Nagle**

Finished Placemat Size  
17<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 12<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"

Number of Blocks & Finished Size  
**4 Trip Around the World Blocks**  
9<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 9<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"

### Plan

Diane cleverly adapted the traditional one-patch Trip Around the World block to create pieced hearts. She used prints from the *Espirit Maison* collection by Robyn Pandolph for RJR Fabrics along with a variety of pink Cotton Supreme Solid fabrics in differing shades, arranged concentrically around the heart to create a subtly graduated background that she filled with exquisite quilting. Diane recommends that if you use pale pink fabrics that are very close in color that you mark each patch to aid in correct fabric placement. You may find it helpful to use a design wall or other flat surface to arrange the patches before sewing them together. Our pattern provides yardage and instructions for making 4 placemats.

### Shop

Assorted dark pink and purple florals and textures (blocks, borders)	1 yd. <b>total</b>
Dark pink dot (blocks, binding)	3/4 yd.
Ivory solid (blocks)	1/4 yd.
Assorted pale pink solids (blocks, 2nd border)	5/8 yd. <b>total</b>
Light pink solid (blocks)	1/4 yd.
Medium pink solid (blocks)	1/4 yd.
Backing	1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yds.
Batting size	4 rectangles 22" x 17"



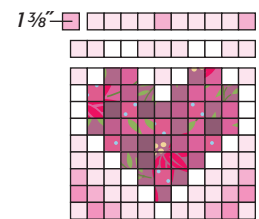
### Cut

#### (cut in order listed)

Assorted dark pink and purple florals and textures — **cut a total of:**  
 \*8 strips 3" x 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 \*8 strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 18<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 \*8 strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 156 squares 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 Dark pink dot  
 8 strips 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x width of fabric (binding)  
 28 squares 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 Ivory solid  
 96 squares 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 Assorted pale pink solids — **cut a total of:**  
 \*8 strips 1" x 16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 \*8 strips 1" x 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 152 squares 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 Light pink solid  
 36 squares 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 Medium pink solid  
 16 squares 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"  
 \*Border strips are cut to exact length.

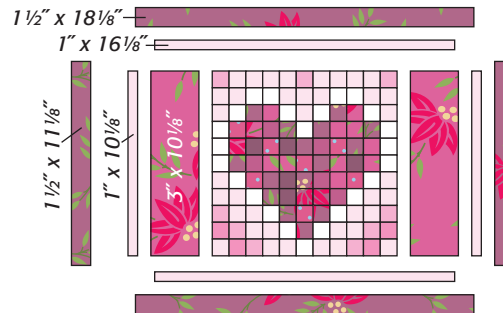
### Sew

**1** Sew together 11 rows of 11 assorted dark pink and purple floral and texture, dark pink dot, ivory solid, assorted pale pink solid, light pink solid and medium pink solid 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares to make Trip Around the World Block (**Diagram 1**).

- 2 Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps. Sew dark pink floral 3" x 10 1/8" strips to sides of block.
- 3** Stitch pale pink solid 1" x 10 1/8" strips to sides then sew pale pink solid 1" x 16 1/8" strips to top and bottom.
- 4** Stitch purple floral 1 1/2" x 11 1/8" strips to sides then sew purple floral 1 1/2" x 18 1/8" strips to top/bottom.
- 5** Layer, baste, and quilt. Diane machine quilted cross-hatching in the heart, swirls in the pink background, and vertical lines in borders. Bind with dark pink dot. Repeat steps 1-5 to make 4 placemats.
