Finished Quilt Size **78½" x 93½"**

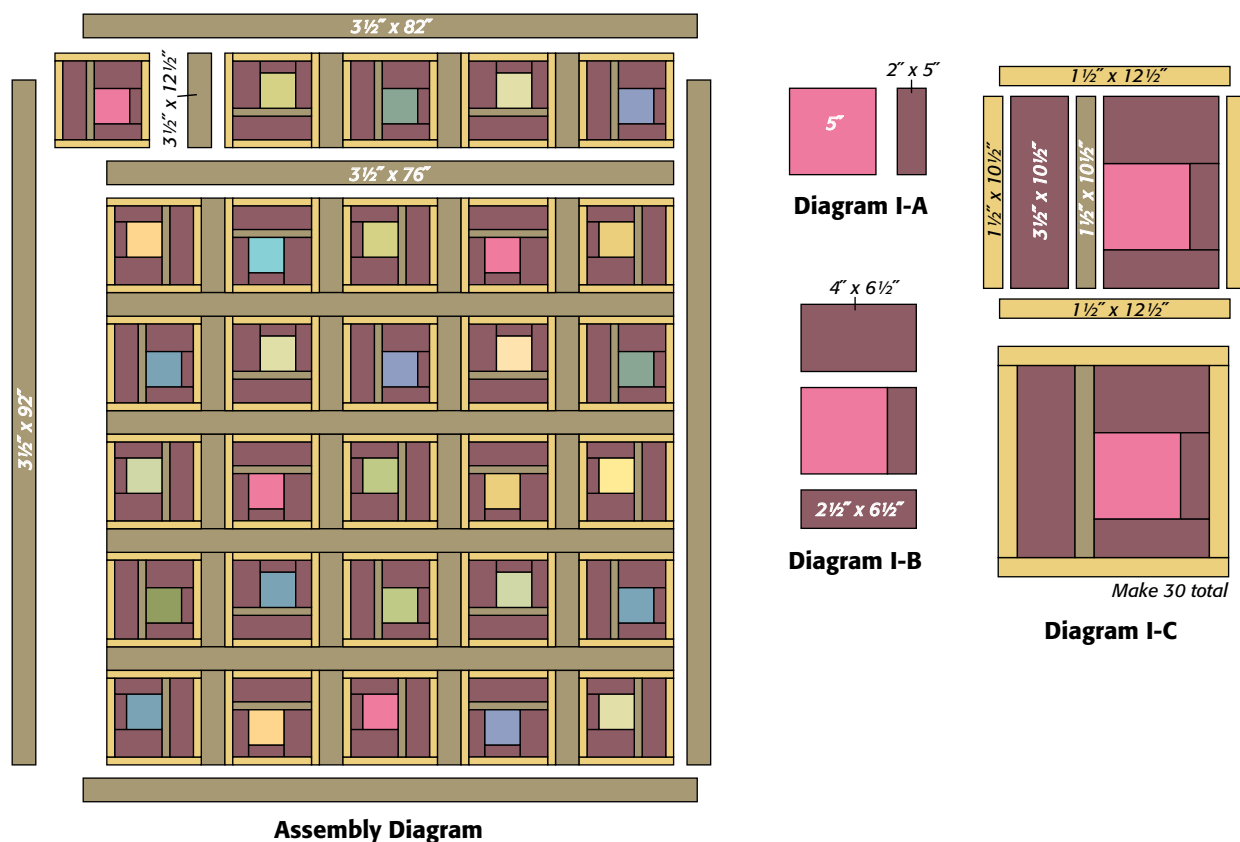
Number of Blocks and Finished Size
30 Pieced Blocks 12" x 12"

plan

Asymmetrical blocks and warm solids combine to give a modern look to this easy quilt. Notice how the burgundy in the blocks really makes the brighter colors stand out. You may wish to use a charm pack in place of the assorted solids yardage. A charm pack consists of approximately 40 squares 5" x 5", all from one fabric collection.

shop

Assorted pink, lime, green, teal, yellow, and blue solids (blocks)	¾-1 yd. total*
Burgundy solid (blocks, binding)	3¼ yds.
Dark tan solid (blocks, sashing, border)	3¾ yds.
Gold solid (blocks)	2 yds.
Backing (piece widthwise)	7¾ yds.
Batting size	88" x 102"

cut

(in order listed)

Assorted pink, lime, green, teal, yellow, and blue solids—**cut a total of:**

30 squares 5" x 5"

Burgundy solid

10 strips 2 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) for binding

30 strips 3 1/2" x 10 1/2"

30 rectangles 4" x 6 1/2"

30 strips 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

30 strips 2" x 5"

Dark tan solid

*2 strips 3 1/2" x 92", cut on lengthwise grain

*2 strips 3 1/2" x 82", cut on lengthwise grain

*5 strips 3 1/2" x 76", cut on lengthwise grain

24 strips 3 1/2" x 12 1/2"

30 strips 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Gold solid

60 strips 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"

60 strips 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

*Strips include extra length for trimming.

sew

1 Stitch together 1 assorted solid 5" square and 1 burgundy solid 2" x 5" strip (**Diagram I-A**). Add 1 each burgundy 4" x 6 1/2" rectangle and 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip to make pieced unit (**Diagram I-B**). Referring to **Diagram I-C**, sew together 2 gold solid 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips, 1 burgundy 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" strip, 1 dark tan 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strip, and pieced unit. Add 2 gold 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips to top and bottom to make Pieced Block. Make 30 total.

2 Referring to **Assembly Diagram** and rotating blocks as shown, sew 6 rows using 5 blocks and 4 tan 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips each. Stitch together block rows and tan 92" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Sew 82" strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.

3 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with burgundy solid.
