Counting Ladybugs Web Bonus: Pillow

Designed by Bea Lee

Finished Pillow Size 12" x 12"

Number of Blocks and Finished Size 1 Ladybug Block 9" x 9"

Note: Appliqué templates, at the end of the pattern, are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

Plan

Brighten up a little one's room with this simple ladybug pillow.

*Shop

Green texture (background) 1 fat quarter** Black texture (appliqué) 10" x 10" piece White texture (appliqué) 3" x 3" piece Red texture (appliqué) 8" x 8" piece Orange texture (border, backing) 3/8 yd. Paper-backed fusible web 1/4 yd. 12" x 12" Pillow form

*All fabrics are batiks.

(in order listed, before cutting appliqué)

Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at the end of the pattern.

Green texture

1 square 91/2" x 91/2"

Orange texture

2 rectangles 8" x 121/2"


2 strips 2" x 121/2"

2 strips 2" x 91/2"



Sew

1 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-E on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines. Finger-press green texture 91/2" x 91/2" square in half on both diagonals; use folds as placement guide. Position A-E (Diagram I). Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine satin stitch or free-motion stitching as Bea did (Diagram II) to complete Ladybug Block.

^{**} A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

5 Insert pillow form inside pillow cover

through flaps.

2 Referring to **Diagram III**, sew orange texture 91/2" strips to sides. Sew orange 121/2" strips to top/bottom to complete pillow front.

3 Turn under 1/2" twice on 1 long edge of orange texture 8" x 121/2" rectangle; press. Stitch close to fold through all layers. Make 2.

- 4 Layer pillow front and both backing rectangles, right sides together and raw edges aligned (**Diagram IV**). Hemmed sides of backing rectangles will overlap at center. Stitch 1/4" from raw edges. Trim corners and turn right side out through opening at overlapped edges.


