

## Weathervane Block

## Finished Block Size

$12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)
Lime solid
4 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
12 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
Red solid
1 square $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 squares $27 /^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
4 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Blue solid
4 squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Piecing the Block

(1) Draw diagonal line on wrong side of lime $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place marked square on red $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together (Diagram I). Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 8.

(2) Sew together 1 each lime and red $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and 2 pieced squares to make corner unit (Diagram II). Make 4.

(3) Draw diagonal line on wrong side of lime $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place marked square on blue $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together, aligning raw edges (Diagram III). Sew on marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Open and press. In same manner, add lime square to adjacent corner to make edge unit. Make 4.

Referring to Diagram IV, sew 3 rows using 4 corner units, 4 edge units, and red $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew rows together to make Weathervane Block.
