

Web Bonus: Wizard's Chess

Alternate Size Options

Wizard's Chess with its bright colors would be great in any size! Our handy chart of alternate sizes provides everything you need to know. Use it along with the Wizard's Chess pattern from *Quick Quilts*, June/July 2017.

The chart indicates the quilt size, the block setting (i.e. the number of blocks across and down) and the resulting number of blocks to make. It gives yardage for each fabric used in the quilt as well as backing and batting information.

Alternate sizes for Wizard's Chess are crib, queen and king. The original pattern in *Quick Quilts* is for a 64" x 64" throw-size quilt.

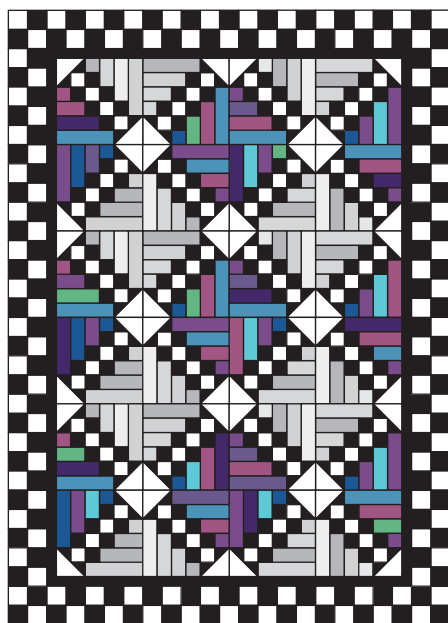

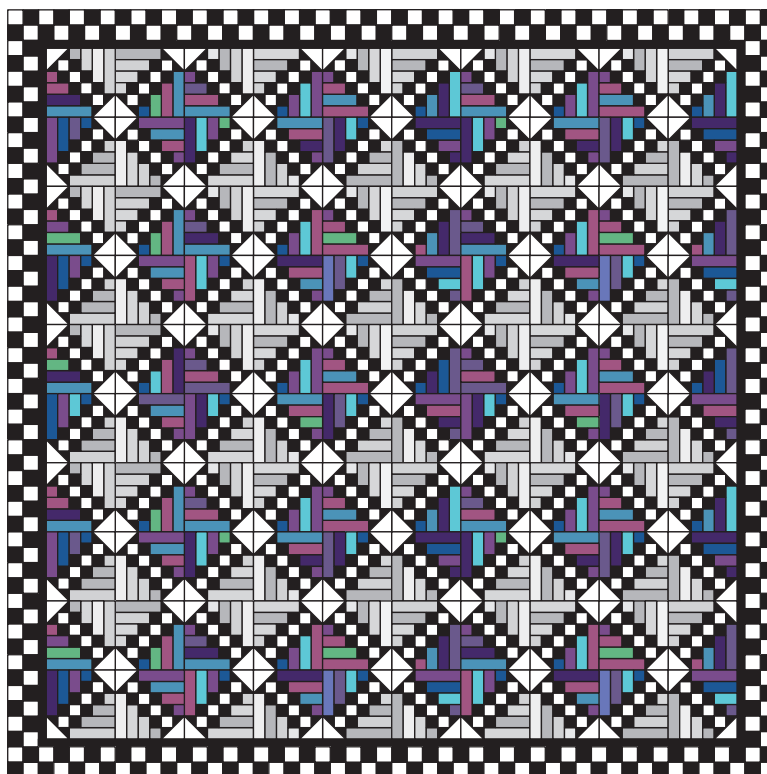
*Queen and king-size quilts have the same number of blocks. The checkerboard border for the queen-size quilt is 2 patches wide. The checkerboard border on the king-size quilt is 4 patches wide.

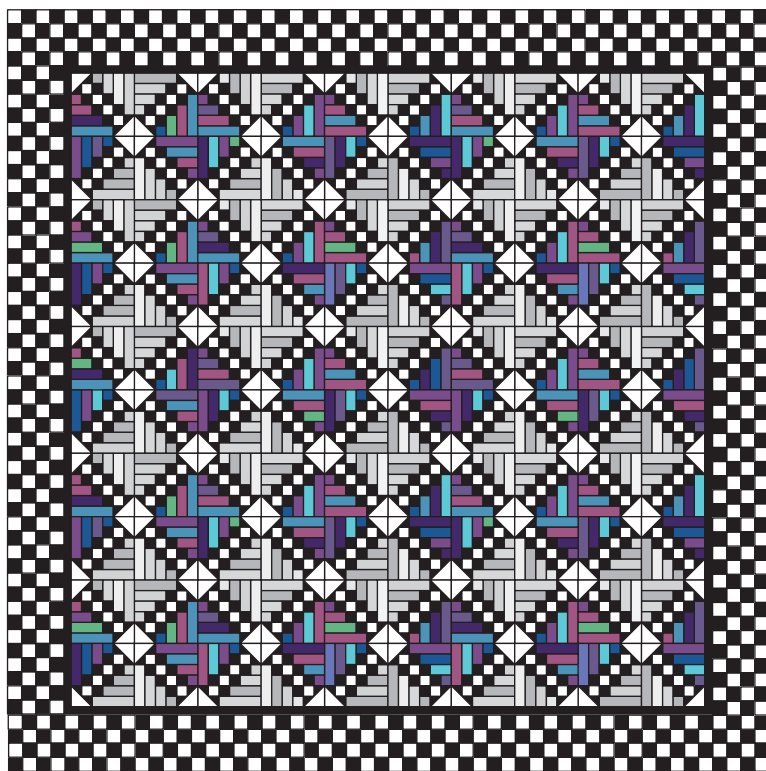
